Grade Level News



1st Grade—First grade has begun academic learning stations, small group instruction and intervention this past month. Our students are working hard with their learning. We are so proud of their continued efforts. Please try to have your child on campus before 7:45am so that they can enjoy breakfast prior to the start of the school day.
