- The scholarship winners will be notified by email and letter, and also be contacted to arrange for rehearsals in preparation to **perform in concert on April 14th** with a band provided by the Space Coast Jazz Society.
- The scholarship money is sent directly to the school of continuing education. Scholarships are valid from the time of the award through the fall semester of the following year (i.e. Spring 2024 through Fall 2025). If the student has not used the scholarship within that time period, the money will be returned to the Space Coast Jazz Society's education fund.

4. A statement from 2 references with a brief commentary about your talent, character, and seriousness of intent.
5. A short audio or video of you performing **SOLO** (YouTube links are acceptable). It does not have to be professional quality, but does need to be audible.
