The Orange County Regional History Center's Adventures in History Summer Camp is a great way to earn community-service hours, and it's an excellent opportunity for future teachers.

Our camp runs May 28 – August 2, 2024, for ten weeks.

SHIFTS: Volunteers must be able to work one full week of camp at a time. Camp volunteer shifts take place Monday through Friday, with varying timeframes between the hours of 7:30 a.m. - 5:30 p.m. Youth volunteers are scheduled for five hours per day, and shift availability may vary on days when campers attend field trips.

DUTIES: Volunteers assist teachers and children with camp games, crafts, activities, breaks, and museum exploration while following all classroom rules and serving as role models.

TO APPLY: Email teacher's letter of recommendation to Diane.Masciale@ocfl.net by March 22, 2024. A link to apply will be sent to you when letter of recommendation has been received.

New volunteers & guardians must attend screening registration together. (Valid ID & Social Security Card required.)

Volunteers must attend a mandatory orientation and complete a background screening, required by Orange County and the state of Florida, by May 31, 2024.
