
History of Ralph M. Williams, Jr.

Our school is named after a dedicated educator who served Brevard Public Schools for 39 years. Ralph Medicus Williams, Jr. was the Area III Superintendent at the time of his death in 1998. The native and lifelong resident of Merritt Island began his career as a teacher and throughout the years held top administrative positions in Brevard Public Schools. In addition to his focus on schools, Williams was a highly active and respected member of the broader community. Williams believed "There is nothing more rewarding than assisting with the things that help schools to improve." He loved his work and described Brevard Public Schools as "The best!" Ralph M.
