



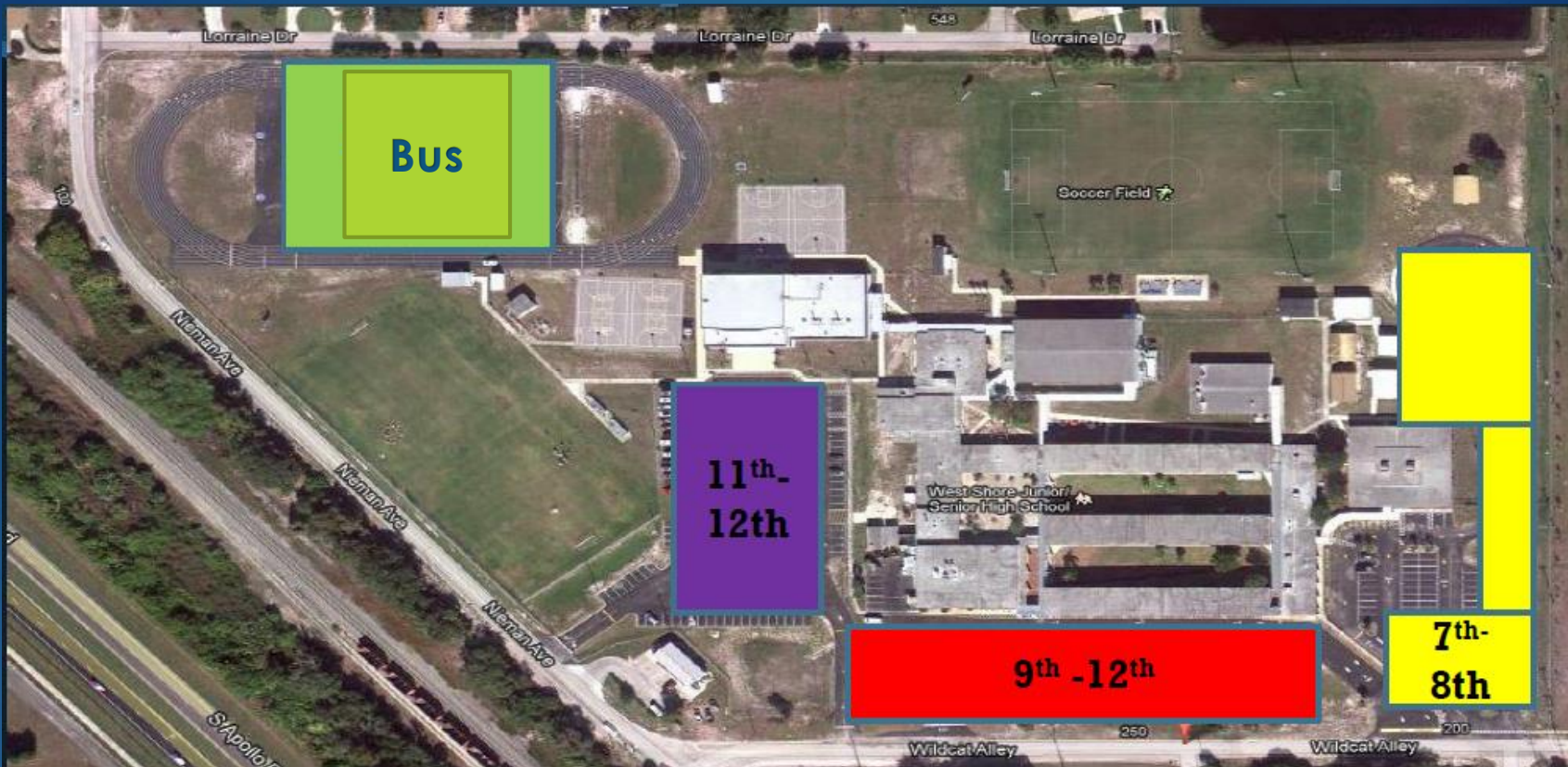

Traffic Management Plan

The drop off and pick up areas are assigned by grade level. The **YELLOW** loop is for 7th and 8th grades and is located on the East side of the campus. When utilizing this loop parents are asked to enter onto Wildcat Alley from Babcock Street and turn right into the loop. When exiting the loop parents should **turn left** only to avoid congestion at the entrance/exit of the other loop.




The **RED** loop is for 9th-12th grades and is located on the South side of the campus. Parents using this loop are directed to turn onto Wildcat Alley from Nieman Avenue. When departing this loop parents are to make a **right turn** only and return to Nieman Avenue.



The main entrance to the student lot will be through the gate on Nieman Avenue. Should students arrive after the start of 1st period, they should enter through the gate located on Wildcat Alley.

Important Note

Pick up and drop off is **NO LONGER** permitted on the track in the rear of the school. Either the high school or middle school loop must be utilized.



Student drop off and pick up is not permitted in the student lot in front of the auditorium between the hours of 8am and 4pm.

For everyone's safety, please use the designated locations for drop off and pick up.

There is no approved parking at the Melbourne Courthouse or the adjacent parking lot.
