## **Call to Order**

The meeting was called to order by Susan Orton at 4:02 PM.

## **Review/Approval of April Meeting Minutes**

The April 2018 minutes were reviewed. There was a motion to approve the minutes by Carol Rosasco, motion seconded by Rick Fleming. The vote was all in favor; motion passed.

## **National Blue Ribbon Application**

The West Shore application for the National Blue Ribbon Award was submitted electronically to the U.S. Department of Education on Friday, April 27, 2018. The application will be reviewed and the school will be certified for the award in September after school grades are announced. If West Shore wins this 3<sup>rd</sup> National Blue Ribbon, Mr. Fleming will travel to Washington D.C. to pick up award in November 2018. Following his return to West Shore, there will be a Blue Ribbon celebration for students and staff.

## **Testing**

All of the FSA and EOC tests have been completed by the students. The Advanced Placement exams are now being administered until May 25<sup>th</sup>. Next year, the Florida Department of Education has decided that all FSA and EOC tests will only be given in May 2019.

## **Webb's Depth of Knowledge (DOK) Results**

Mr. Fleming explained that the teacher focus for professional development for this year was the use of Higher Order Questioning in the classrooms with students. Webb's DOK categorizes teacher classroom questioning from Level 1 to Level 4 (Level 1 is considered recall of facts, Level 2 is skill knowledge, Level 3 is strategic thinking, and Level 4 is extended thinking). The emphasis on this type of questioning will continue next year for teacher professional development.

## **Budget**

The SLC summer team will be working on updating the curriculum notebooks for each Homeroom class in the month of June. The teachers on that team will be paid from SAC money which was approved at the SAC meeting in April.

## **Staffing**

There will be some changes in the staff at the beginning of the school year in August. Maria Cintron, Spanish teacher, has resigned and is moving to North Carolina. Jim Peterson, Careers teacher, is retiring.

## **2018-2019 SAC Roster**

The students have voted for their 2018-2019 SAC representatives.
