Review/Approval of May Meeting Minutes

SIP Focus

Mr. Fleming explained the focus of improvement for the school will be the continuation of Higher Order Questioning Skills being used in the classrooms along with CRISS (Creating Independence through Student Owned Strategies). A first draft of the West Shore SIP will be submitted on Friday, Sept. 21st to Dr. Stephanie Soliven, Assistant Superintendent of Leading & Learning. The final SIP draft will be presented and reviewed at the October SAC meeting in preparation for submission on November 9th. Once the students receive their results, then they can link the PSAT with the online Khan Academy for their free online SAT practice to help them prepare for the SAT. Mr. Fleming wanted to thank the West Shore PTA for funding the 11^{th} grade testing costs because this is a very important way for West Shore students to be recognized by the National Merit Scholar program.
