



SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

The Iberville Parish School Board (IPSB) is ready to continue its path to excellence and is seeking an exceptional Superintendent of Schools to lead those efforts. The IPSB serves a diverse population of 4,072 students on 13 campuses with approximately 980 employees. It has an annual operating budget of approximately \$150,000,000. Iberville Parish has approximately 30,000 citizens and is located only 20 minutes from Baton Rouge.

Qualifications: Applicants must be certified as a superintendent in Louisiana at the time of application or be eligible for immediate certification, as confirmed in writing by the LDOE, at the time of application. You must furnish your LDOE confirmation of certification along with your completed application. Please note that the applicant must possess the credentials which entitle him/her to serve as the district's superintendent. Each applicant must meet or exceed, as of the date of application, the qualifications for superintendent listed in Bulletin 746 Louisiana Standards for State Certification of School Personnel.

Applications: Applications for the position of Superintendent of Schools may be found and printed off the IPSB website (www.ipsb.net). Applications must be completed, signed, and delivered as outlined below to be considered.

Deadline for Applications: All applications must be **received on or before August 18, 2026**. Applications not received by that date will not be considered.

Salary: The salary for this position is negotiable based on the experience of the applicant. The estimated salary range is \$150,000-\$190,000 per year.
