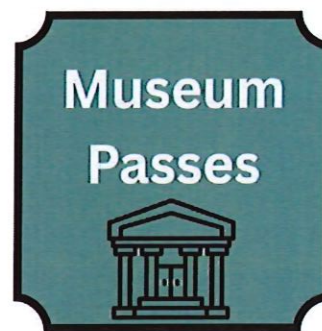
It is one of 3 new exhibitions at the Storm King Arts center.

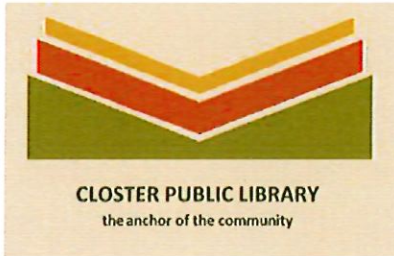

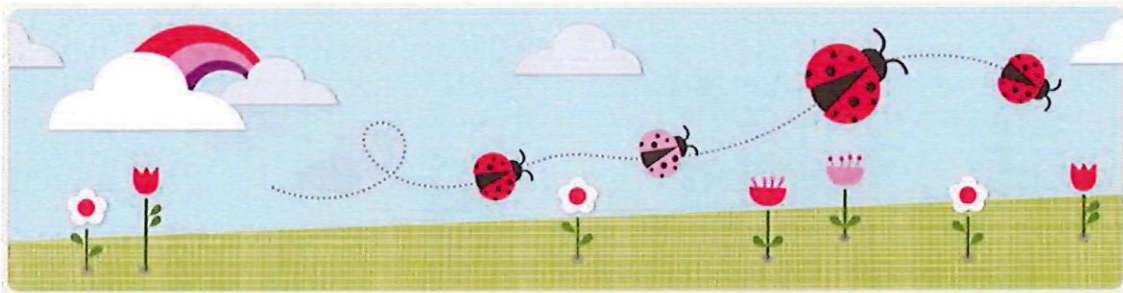
