Regular Meeting

The Mayor and City Council met in regular session on Tuesday February 4, 2025, at 4:00 p.m. in the G. Thomas Love Boardroom at the Greeneville Energy Authority Building with Mayor C. Calvin Doty presiding.

Present were Council Members Matt Hensley, Ginny Kidwell, Tim Teague, Tim Ward, and Todd Smith, City Manager.

At this time, Mayor Doty's comments are as follows: 1) Please keep in your thoughts and prayers former Council Member Bullington as he has been experiencing health issues over the last several weeks; and 2) Recognition of Greene County Partnership's Youth Leadership program participants.

Motion by Council Member Hensley, seconded by Council Member Teague to add the following item to today's agenda: Consideration to approve an appointment to the Greeneville Energy Authority Board, Mr. Justin Jeffers. Motion passed unanimously.

No public comment on the items on this agenda.

Motion by Council Member Kidwell, seconded by Council Member Ward to approve the minutes from the regularly scheduled meeting held on Tuesday, January 21, 2025. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Council Member Ward, seconded by Council Member Kidwell to approve a Special Event Application for the Greeneville City Schools Education Foundation to host Mardi Growl Dog Parade on March 1, 2025. Amanda Waddell, Executive Director of the Greeneville City Schools Education Foundation, addressed the Council. The duration of the event will be approximately one- and one-half hours. Motion passed unanimously.

At this time, Amanda Waddell also took the time to note that twenty-six students from Greeneville High School received a score above 30 on the ACT college entrance exam.

Motion by Council Member Ward, seconded by Council Member Hensley to approve a Special Event Application for Keep Greene Beautiful to host the Iris Festival Kick-Off 3-mile run and walk on May 13, 2025. Jessie Beth Miller, Community Engagement Director for the Greene County Partnership, addressed the Council. This event will be held on a Tuesday evening this year, to open additional time on Saturday for the 30th Annual Iris Festival additional activities this year. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Council Member Hensley, seconded by Council Member Kidwell to approve a Special Event Application for the Greene County Partnership to host Brewfest on May 17, 2025. Christina Potts, Marketing and Media Coordinator, addressed the Council. This event will take place from 3 p.m. until 8 p.m. and will have a \$25.00 entry fee for all participants. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Council Member Hensley, seconded by Council Member Kidwell to approve a Special Event Application for the Mattie J CPR Foundation to host the Duck Dash 5k and 1-Mile Fun Run on May 24, 2025. James Edwards, Founder of the Mattie J CPR Foundation, addressed the Council. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Council Member Ward, seconded by Council Member Hensley to approve the appointment of Mr. Justin Jeffers to the Greeneville Energy Authority Board of Directors. Motion passed unanimously.
