

UNOFFICIAL MINUTES

Regular Meeting

The Mayor and City Council met in regular session on Tuesday November 4, 2025, at 4:00 p.m. in the G. Thomas Love Boardroom at the Greeneville Energy Building with Mayor C. Calvin Doty presiding.

Present were Council Members Ginny Kidwell, Matt Hensley, Tim Teague, Tim Ward, and Interim City Manager Cathy Osborne.

At this time, Mayor Doty's comments are as follows: 1) Eddie Key, Police Captain, announced Second Harvest Food Bank would be providing a food distribution on Wednesday, November 5, 2025, for SNAP benefit recipients for Greene County residents only. This event will be held at the Greene County Fairgrounds; 2) Several activities took place last week, including Halloween Happenings held downtown and Halloween in the Park, held at Hardin Park. All events were well attended; and 3) The Greeneville High School Lady Devils Golf team won the State Championship in October 2025. Golf team members Brylee Catron, Kylee Renner and Kamryn Renner were presented with Town of Greeneville challenge coins by Mayor Doty. Also present were Coach Nathan Hale and Assistant Coach Todd Ricker.

No one requested public comment on this agenda.

Motion by Council Member Hensley, seconded by Council Member Kidwell to approve the minutes from the regularly scheduled meeting held on Tuesday, October 21, 2025. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Council Member Hensley, seconded by Council Member Ward to approve the Greene County Heritage Trust to partner with the Town of Greeneville to move forward with the project to make improvements to the Old Harmony Cemetery including an entry, pathway, and signage. Christina Potts, Marketing and Media Specialist, addressed the Council, along with Mr. Tim Massey, representative of the Greene County Heritage Trust. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Council Member Ward, seconded by Council Member Kidwell to appoint Lynn Broyles for a six-year term to serve on the Greeneville Health and Education Facilities Board. Christina Potts, Marketing and Media Specialist, and Cathy Osborne, Interim City Manager, addressed the Council stating this is a seven-member board with three additional upcoming vacancies. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Council Member Teague, seconded by Council Member Kidwell to approve a Hatz diesel replacement engine for the air burner and related components in the amount of \$13,070. Tony Morrison, Landfill Manager, addressed the Council. The accident involving the air burner has been submitted for evaluation and possible reimbursement from the Town's property insurance carrier. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Council Member Teague, seconded by Council Member Kidwell to approve the purchase of three (3) shade structures for the beach volleyball complex in the amount of \$18,287.12. Brandon Norton, Athletic Coordinator, addressed the Council stating this purchase was part of the Tourism Enhancement Grant funded project. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Council Member Hensley, seconded by Council Member Ward to approve a special event sign request for "A Christmas You Can Only Imagine" held at the Dickson Williams

Mansion on December 5, 2025. Bert Seay, Building Department Director, addressed the Council.
Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Council Member Teague seconded by Council Member Kidwell to adjourn.
