### Regular Meeting

The Mayor and City Council met in regular session on Tuesday May 20, 2025, at 4:00 p.m. in the G. Thomas Love Boardroom at the Greeneville Energy Building with Vice-Mayor Tim Teague presiding.

Present were Council Members Matt Hensley, Ginny Kidwell, Tim Ward, and Todd Smith, City Manager.

No one registered for public comment regarding an item on today's agenda.

Motion by Council Member Kidwell, seconded by Council Member Hensley to approve the minutes from the regularly scheduled meeting held on Tuesday, May 6, 2025. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Council Member Ward, seconded by Council Member Kidwell to approve a bid from Midway Construction in the amount of \$19,778 for water and sewer line repairs for the Greeneville/Greene County Library. Erin Evans, Library Director, addressed the Council, stating that Greene County had agreed to pay up to \$25,000 for this project in the fiscal year 2026 budget. Town of Greeneville Public Works Department can assist with the stone and asphalt needed for the project in the amount of \$5,000. Motion passed unanimously.
