

UNOFFICIAL MINUTES

Regular Meeting

The Mayor and City Council met in regular session on Tuesday October 15, 2024, at 4:00 p.m. in the G. Thomas Love Boardroom at the Greeneville Energy Authority Building with Mayor C. Calvin Doty presiding.

Present were Council Members Matt Hensley, Ginny Kidwell, Tim Teague, Council Member Tim Ward, and Todd Smith, City Manager.

At this time, Mayor Doty's comments are as follows: 1) The boil water advisory has been lifted; 2) In the past two weeks, the community came together to address the natural disaster. Thank you to everyone involved at the Emergency Command Center including Tennessee Wildlife Resource Agency, Volunteer Fire Departments, City and County representatives, various public safety offices, and the Emergency Management staff. Thank you to the area churches and non-profits that provided much needed meals and supplies. A special thank you is extended to the Greeneville Water Commission and Greeneville Energy Authority for their extraordinary efforts to restore water and electricity to all residents of Greeneville and Greene County within 10 days after the natural disaster began; 3) Special thank you to Mr. Ron Metcalf with WGRV for the continuous updates during the initial two weeks of the weather event; and 4) Honor Flight of Appalachian Highlands was presented a proclamation recognizing October 15, 2024 as Honor Flight of the Appalachian Highlands Day. In attendance were: Michelle Steward, President; Richard Sells, Vietnam Veteran; and James Patterson, Vietnam Veteran.

No public comment for the items on this agenda.

Motion by Council Member Ward, seconded by Council Member Hensley to approve the minutes from the regularly scheduled meeting held on Tuesday, October 1, 2024. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Council Member Kidwell, seconded by Council Member Ward to approve the minutes from the special called meeting held on Thursday, October 10, 2024. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Council Member Teague, seconded by Council Member Ward to approve a Resolution to issue a capital outlay note in an amount not to exceed \$1,400,000 to purchase equipment for the Greeneville Demolition Landfill. Lora Young, Finance Director, addressed the Council. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Council Member Teague, seconded by Council Member Ward to approve an amendment to the Joint Venture Agreement for the Greeneville/Greene County Landfill. Lora Young, Finance Director, addressed the Council. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Council Member Kidwell, seconded by Council Member Hensley to approve the bid award to conduct a pavement condition index study for the Public Works Department. Scott Keith, Assistant Public Works Director, addressed the Council. Five firms responded to the bid request with Withers Ravenel chosen as the firm to conduct the pavement assessment. This is a budgeted item in the State Street Aid fund. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Council Member Hensley, seconded by Council Member Ward to adjourn. Motion passed unanimously.
