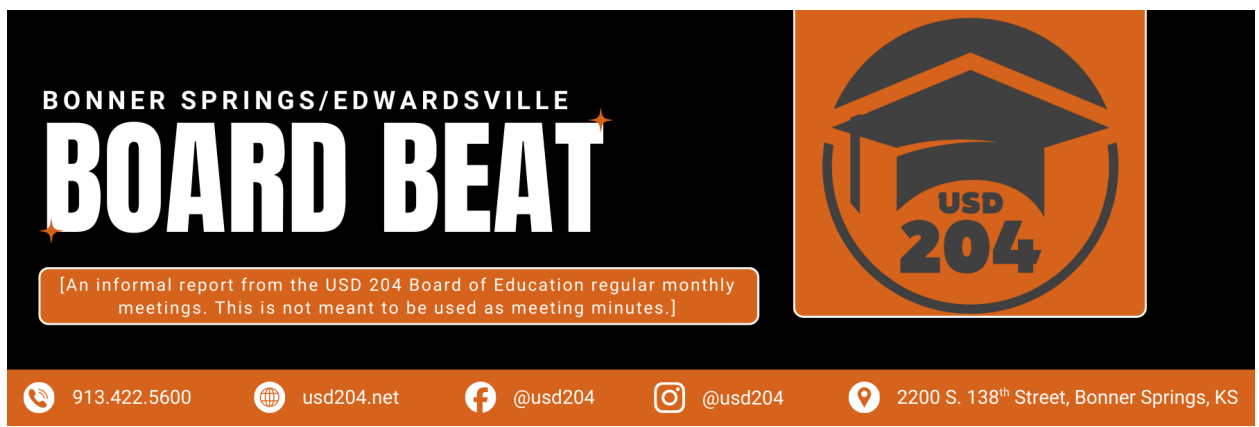




Meeting Date: Monday, June 1, 2026 - District Office

President Angie Thomas called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Mr. Carter Stolberg, BSHS Robotics sponsor, and students Carter Shirley, Elias Lindsey, and Brycen Smith (Olathe School District) presented on the robotics season this past school year.

- Fundraising is the biggest challenge for the season, so the team will be focusing on fundraising and increasing their business sponsorships next year.



The Board approved the Minutes from the May 4, 2026 meeting and the Warrant Register and Financials.

Dr. Porter presented the request to process claims and transfer funds to close fiscal year 2026.

- The Board approved the processing of claims and transferring of funds to close fiscal year 2026.

Mr. Moulin discussed the increase of school lunch prices to meet USDA Meal Pricing Guidelines. The recommendation for meal prices for the 26-27 school year is to increase student lunches by 10¢. Adult meals will increase by 20¢ and 30¢ for breakfast and lunch, respectively.

- The Board approved the increase in school lunch and adult meal pricing.

Mr. Moulin discussed student accident insurance, which is an optional insurance that the Board of Education has purchased for several years, which covers students' accidents that occur at school or during a school event. The insurance serves as secondary insurance for students who have insurance and primary insurance for students who do not have insurance. This year's cost is an increase of \$1,473.65 over last year.

- The Board approved the increase in the student accident insurance purchase.

Dr. Porter presented District Handbooks updated for the 2026-2027 school year. These are a first read for BOE members to look at and approve next month.

- The only change in the student handbooks is the updated policy that HB 2299 requires for the cell phone/electronic devices ban.
- Personnel handbooks include communication/cell phone policy updates, as well

Mr. Stokka recommended removal of the chimneys at BSE and Head Start, as they no longer serve operational purposes and are showing signs of weathering. The project will be funded through Capital Outlay.

- The Board approved the chimney removals at BSE and Head Start.

Mr. Stokka discussed the transportation building gutters that need to be replaced. This project will be funded through Capital Outlay.

- The Board approved the transportation building gutter replacement.

Mr. Moulin and Mr. Stokka presented a donation for the BSHS Robotics program - two milling machines from Lee's Summit High School. Lee's Summit school district will transport the machines to the BTEC and they will be set up in the shop with the help of our Facilities team.

- The Board approved the donation from Lee's Summit School District for the two milling machines.
