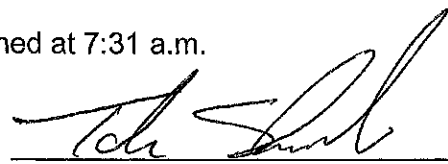
Mayor Shields closed the public hearing at 7:25 a.m.

DISCUSS AND CONSIDER ORDINANCE NO. 967, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SPEARMAN, TEXAS ANNEXING 10.344 ACRES OF LAND, MORE OR LESS, LOCATED IN HANSFORD COUNTY INTO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY, AT THE REQUEST OF THE PROPERTY OWNERS; APPROVING AN AGREEMENT FOR THE PROVISION OF SERVICES FOR THE ANNEXED AREA; MAKING FINDINGS OF FACT; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR OPEN MEETINGS AND OTHER RELATED MATTERS

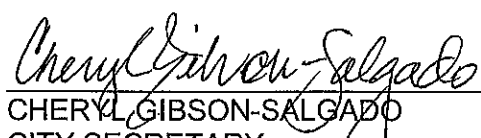
