MINUTES**

1. **CALL TO ORDER:** Tompkins called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM
2. **PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**
3. **ROLL CALL:** Mohr called the roll, Trustee Colravy, Schriver, Harpst, Oliger and Metzger are present. Trustee Willard is absent. Additionally, Jason Tompkins, Village President, Patrick Brown, Village Administrator, Joe Chamley, Village Attorney, Carole Tempel, Village Treasurer, Abby Heckman, Village Planner, Ellen Hedrick, Village Engineer, Dave Smysor, Chief of Police and Dawn Mohr, Village Clerk are all present.
4. **PUBLIC COMMENT:** No public comment
5. **PUBLIC HEARING:** Tompkins opens the public hearing at 6:00, there is nobody in attendance for the public hearing. Tompkins called for a motion to close the public hearing at 6:01 PM. Metzger moved and Harpst seconded. Mohr called the roll, ALL VOTES YES 5-0. The public hearing is closed at 6:01 PM.

6. **APPROVAL OF ANNUAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION OF THE VILLAGE OF MAHOMET, ILLINOIS. (TO BE ACTED UPON):**
 - A. Ordinance 26-05-01, Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance of the Village of Mahomet, Illinois. Tompkins asked if there was any questions or comments before voting on the ordinance, none are presented. Tompkins called for a motion to approve the ordinance, Schriver moved and Metzger seconded. Mohr called the roll, ALL VOTES YES 5-0. The ordinance is approved.
 - B. Resolution 25-06-01, A Resolution Approving the 5-Year Capital Improvement Plan for Fiscal Year 2027 Through 2031. Tompkins asked if there were any questions or comments. None is presented, Tompkins called for a motion to approve the resolution. Metzger moved and Colravy seconded. Mohr called the roll, ALL VOTES YES 5-0. The resolution is approved.

8. REGULAR AGENDA (TO BE ACTED UPON):

A. POLICE:

1. Resolution 26-05-07, A Resolution Increasing the Authorized Full Time Strength of the Police Department from Fifteen to Sixteen Sworn Staffing Level Positions. Tompkins explained that this item was presented at the study session and recapped that the increase is to allow the department to move an officer into the position of investigator/detective and then hire a new patrol officer. Tompkins asked if there were any questions or comments, none were presented. Tompkins called for a

motion to approve the resolution. Harpst moved and Oliger seconded. Mohr called the roll, ALL VOTES YES 5-0. The resolution is approved.

B. COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT:

1. Resolution 26-05-08, A Resolution Authorizing a Professional Services Agreement with Smithgroup for Professional Services Associated with a Village Comprehensive Plan Update in the Amount Not to Exceed \$179,500.00. Heckman goes over the revised plan as requested and introduces Kathleen with Smithgroup. She goes over the agreement in brief and welcomes questions from the board. Tompkins asked what experience Smithgroup has with communities that are similar in size to Mahomet. Kathleen responds that they have experience with communities as small as a population of 700 all the way up to a city the size of Detroit. Schriver asked if Smithgroup has any experience with communities with similar growth profiles. Kathleen responded that they have had similar experiences, one in Indiana and the other in Wisconsin. Schriver followed up asking if there were any communities in Illinois similar in growth as Mahomet. Kathleen answered that they will be looking for communities in Illinois. Schriver pointed out that the school overcrowding is a hot topic and residential growth is a concern as we don't want to add additional stress on the school district. Tompkins thanks Kathleen and asks if there are any more questions or comments, none are presented. Tompkins called for a motion to approve the resolution Metzger moved and Colravy seconded. Mohr called the roll, ALL VOTES YES 5-0 The resolution is approved.

C. ENGINEERING:

1. Resolution 26-05-09, A Resolution Awarding the Bituminous Street Maintenance Project to Evergreen Roadworks, LLC for the Amount of \$365,000. Hedrick goes over the project highlighting the areas that will be done this year. She explains how only one bid was received and the reasoning for only a single bidder, Evergreen is currently the only company who offers this type of work. Metzger asked where this project is in the budget. Brown explained that it is under Transportation CIP. Brown adds that the increase in oil cost has driven the pricing up. Tompkins asked if there were any other questions or comments, none were presented. Tompkins called for a motion to approve the resolution. Oliger moved and Harpst seconded. Mohr called the roll, ALL VOTES YES 5-0. The resolution is approved.

D. **MAYOR:** Tompkins went over the appointment resolutions as a group and asked if there were any comments or questions, none are presented. Tompkins called for a motion to approve Resolution 26-05-10-26-05-17. Metzger moved and Schriver seconded. Mohr called the roll, ALL VOTES YES 5-0. Resolution 26-05-10 – 26-05-17 are approved.
