

**VILLAGE OF MAHOMET
STUDY SESSION
JULY 19, 2022**

The Village of Mahomet Board of Trustees met, Tuesday, July 19, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. at the Village of Mahomet Administrative Offices, 503 E. Main St., Mahomet, IL.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Sean Widener, Bruce Colravy, Jason Tompkins, Bill Oliger and Brian Metzger and Andy Harpst.

ABSENT: Becky Preston

OTHERS PRESENT: Village Administrator Patrick Brown, Clerk Amanda Andersen, Village Attorney Joe Chamley, Chief of Police Mike Metzler, Finance Director Carole Tempel, Mayor of Oakwood Heather McCarty.

CALL TO ORDER/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE/ROLL CALL:

Widener called the Study Session to order. Pledge of Allegiance then Andersen called the Roll, and a quorum was present.

PUBLIC COMMENT: No Comment

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT:

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING CONSTRUCTION PLANS FOR UNLIMITED VILLAS SUBDIVISION ON 1.8± ACRES OF LAND LOCATED SOUTH OF PATTON DRIVE AND NORTH OF DELANE DRIVE APPROXIMATELY 230 FEET WEST OF CHURCHILL ROAD.

Brown stated unlimited holdings purchased property between Bridal Brook and the condos at the edge of Churchill-zoning change already approved a couple years ago. They have submitted construction plans and a little bit of cleanup of the process. He is trying to do exactly what is there with the condos now-similar look. The difference is that they would have driveways that come out onto Patton Drive.

ROLL CALL:ALL YES. Motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Tempel stated 17% of revenues and 20% for expenditures collected. We are early in FY-not many comparisons. We have received 1-3 of real estate tax disbursements for TIF pass thru's. Tempel did confirm we finally receive the information we requested.

Tempel said it's standard, only exception is for work done on SMR.

Colravy moved, Metzger seconded, "TO MOVE THE BILL LIST TO THE CONSENT AGENDA FOR THE JULY 19, 2022, BOARD MEETING." ROLL CALL: ALL YES. Motion carried.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS:

1. **PARKS AND REC-**Pour in place surface was done last week.
2. **TRANSPORTATION-** We are pouring some own sidewalks, going well. Stop sign has been replaced by Sangamon on Main.
3. **POLICE-** Calls are down from last year.
4. **ENGINEERING-**SMR work underway-any trustees can go see, just contact Ellen. Metzger asked if we are expecting something on Tin Cup? Brown said yes, next PZC.

6. **WATER/WASTEWATER-**we had 2 boil orders over the weekend. Only affected small group of houses and they were notified of the order and when it was lifted.

- B. PARK NAMING DISCUSSION-**Widener recommended Freedom Park for what is now being referred to as Village Green, open to other suggestions. Oliger said he likes Village Green the way it is because calling it a "park" might confuse people since there is no playground, etc. Brown stated we already have an area named "Sangamon Greenway" and he thinks if we call it Village Green, it may be confusing. Widener said think about it and will discuss later.

Metzger asked if we are ready for Music Festival? Widener said we are on track.
Colravy wanted to give a shout out to Ameren for giving 2K for roadside clean up.
