**CALL MEETING TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order by Board President Keegan Barkley at 5:01 p.m. with the following members present: Robb Davidson, Kassidi Gilgenast, Laura Gordon, Carol Greenstreet, and Mrs. Barkley.

**RESOLUTION APPOINTING A FINALIST FOR SUPERINTENDENT FOR WOODLAND PARK SCHOOLS**

President Barkley read the resolution appointing Ginger Slocum to the position of Superintendent for Woodland Park School District (Addendum A).

MOTION Greenstreet, second Gordon, to approve the Resolution Appointing a Finalist for Superintendent for Woodland Park Schools.

MOTION CARRIED; Voting Aye – Barkley, Davidson, Gilgenast, Gordon, Greenstreet.

Interim Superintendent Ginger Slocum shared her gratitude to the Board of Education, staff, and the Woodland Park community for their trust and confidence, noting she is deeply honored to serve as Superintendent. She emphasized that the district is more than a workplace to her, highlighting the strong sense of community and shared commitment to students she has witnessed through conversations with families, staff, and community members. She noted that this collective passion provides a strong foundation for moving forward with stability, transparency, fiscal responsibility, and respectful governance. She also shared her commitment to leading as a partner, building trust, and ensuring academic excellence, while valuing staff and strengthening connections across the district so families feel confident in its schools. She concluded by noting that, with a continued focus on students, the district will move beyond past challenges and build a stronger, brighter future together.

President Barkley acknowledged that some community members may have wished the decision had come sooner, but emphasized that going through the full search process gave the Board even greater confidence in Mrs. Slocum's ability to lead the district forward. She noted that the candidate pool was strong and expressed appreciation for the community's involvement in the interview process, sharing that all community feedback received was taken into serious consideration. Barkley shared that the Board did not take the decision lightly, and affirmed that every step of the process was guided by a sincere commitment to doing what is right for students and the district's future.

Secretary Gordon conveyed her sincere appreciation to Grundmeyer, specifically Dave, Jason, and Gary, for their efforts in presenting a highly qualified pool of candidates for the Board's consideration. She noted her pride in presenting these candidates to the community and extended her gratitude to each candidate for their time and participation in the process.

**SUPERINTENDENT CONTRACT APPROVAL**

MOTION Davidson, second Gordon, to approve the Superintendent Contract.

Vice President Greenstreet requested discussion of the superintendent contract, noting she had not yet reviewed the final version. The Board was provided a redlined draft, and upon review, additional corrections were identified. The Board agreed to defer approval of the contract to allow the attorney, President Barkley, and Mrs. Slocum time to finalize the necessary revisions.


