ACE Part-time Instructional Position

Application Process

Step 1 – ACE Application Packet

Applicants must complete an Adult & Community Enrichment (ACE) Part-time Instructor Application Packet.

If applying for an art position, include a website link showcasing your work or provide a sample portfolio of images. For any new class not currently offered at ACE, please include a course outline with weekly topics, proposed number of sessions and total hours, class title, and a course description.

Submit your completed application, along with your resume, to galina.jordan@sarasotacountyschools.net or mail to the ACE office at 4748 Beneva Rd, Sarasota, FL 34233.

Please note that it may take several weeks or months before submissions are reviewed for the next term. Applicants will be contacted **only** if their proposed classes are determined to be a good fit for the ACE program. All applications will be kept on file.

Step 2 - Interview

If your proposed classes are determined to complement the ACE program offerings, you will be contacted to schedule an in-person interview. If applying to teach an art class, please bring samples of your work to the interview.

If selected to move forward in the hiring process, you will receive instructions for completing the Sarasota County School District's employment application to become a part-time employee.

Some instructors choose to teach for ACE as a volunteer. Volunteer requirements include completing an online volunteer application. If you are interested in teaching as a volunteer, additional information will be provided during the interview.

Step 3 – District Online Application

If you need assistance completing the Sarasota County School District's online application, please contact the Human Resources office at 941-927-9000, ext. 31200.

Two references are required. Once you submit your completed application, an automated email will be sent to your references with a short questionnaire. Please notify your references in advance to expect this email.

All required paperwork must be completed before an instructor may begin teaching.

Step 4 – Orientation and Enrollment Requirements

Once eligibility for employment has been verified, all new instructors are required to attend an ACE New Instructor Orientation session. Orientation is scheduled prior to the start of each term and will cover topics such as supplies, equipment requests, payroll procedures, and general information.

Class offerings are subject to minimum enrollment thresholds established in advance by ACE administration. Scheduled classes will proceed only if the minimum enrollment is met. Part-time instructor compensation is contingent upon having sufficient student enrollment and increases on a tiered basis as enrollment grows.

Proof of Employability

Prior to hiring, you will be asked to produce your original social security card and a legal form of identification (driver’s license, passport, etc.). Your social security card **must** exactly match your identification.

Drug Testing and Fingerprinting

Prior to employment, fingerprinting and drug testing are required and paid for by ACE. Your fingerprints will be researched by local, state and federal law enforcement agencies. The School Board of Sarasota County maintains a drug-free workplace. The use of marijuana, including medical marijuana, is not permitted for employees. A positive drug test will result in disqualification from employment.

Compensation

Would you be interested in teaching as a **volunteer** instead of as a paid instructor? Yes____ No____

The hourly pay rate for ACE part-time instructors is based on class enrollment and is determined after the second class session. Compensation is structured on a tiered system tied to the class size relative to the minimum and maximum enrollments established by ACE administration at the time of scheduling. The instructor's pay increases as enrollment rises.

TIER	PAY RATE	CONDITIONS
Base	\$21 per hour	Class enrollment meets assigned minimum
Mid	\$25 per hour	Class enrollment 60% above minimum
Max	\$31 per hour	Class enrollment meets assigned maximum

Base Tier:

Classes that reach their minimum enrollment are paid at the **Base Tier pay rate of \$21 per hour**.

Mid Tier:

Classes that exceed the minimum enrollments by 60% are paid at the Mid Tier pay rate of \$25 per hour. For example: if the class minimum is 6, the Mid Tier pay rate applies once enrollment reaches 10 students.

Max Tier:

Classes that reach the maximum enrollment are paid at the Max Tier pay rate of \$31 per hour.

Below Min:

If class enrollment is less than the assigned minimum and the program administrator deems there is sufficient enrollment to proceed, the instructor has the **option** of proceeding with the class and being paid at the Below Min Tier pay rate of \$18 per hour.

The hourly rate applies to student contact time only. Instructors are not paid for preparation time. Any additional hours are determined by the program administrator. Because compensation is tied to enrollment for each class, instructors teaching multiple classes may receive different pay rates for each class.

Payroll sheets are signed and submitted monthly. Payments are direct deposited into your bank account on the 15th of the following month.

Security Background Check

Prior to employment, your fingerprints will be researched by local, state and federal law enforcement agencies. Sealed or expunged records must be revealed to the School Board of Sarasota County pursuant to F.S.943.0585 and 943.059. Your employment with the Sarasota County School Board is temporary and probationary pending successful processing of your fingerprints. The following questions must be answered truthfully. Conflict of Interest & Non-Solicitation Agreement

As a part-time instructor with Sarasota County Schools, I agree to maintain professional boundaries that support the integrity of the Adult & Community Enrichment program and protect the participants from personal solicitation.

1. Student Privacy & Confidentiality

All student contact information, including names, phone numbers, and email addresses, is confidential and is provided to ACE for class purposes only. Instructors may use this information solely for purposes directly related to their ACE classes. Using students private contact information for personal use, marketing, outreach, or any purpose unrelated to ACE class is prohibited.

2. Conflict of Interest

Instructors must avoid situations in which personal, professional, and financial interests conflict, or appear to conflict, with their responsibilities to ACE. This includes using your teaching position to promote outside ventures.

3. Prohibited Activities

While teaching or interacting with students in connection with ACE, instructors may NOT:

- Solicit students for private lessons, external programs, or classes offered at other organizations.
- Promote, advertise, or market personal businesses, services, or products, including but not limited to books, CDs, artwork, blogs or newsletters.
- Distribute marketing materials or direct students to external paid offerings.
- Sell goods or services or exchange money with students at STC campus or any off-site class locations.

4. Permitted Conduct

While teaching or interacting with students in connection with ACE, instructors MAY:

- Briefly share relevant professional background or credentials as they relate to the subject matter being taught in class.
- Instructors may mention that they've written and published a book, have artwork in a gallery, composed a song, etc.
- Instructors may mention a business they own but any mention of outside work must be informational only and not include calls to action, pricing, or invitations to engage in outside services.

5. Outside Teaching

We recognize that instructors may offer classes at other institutions and venues. However, we ask that similar courses be presented with some distinction. Please aim to differentiate timing, course titles, descriptions, or focus when offering comparable classes locally. This helps minimize participant confusion and supports strong enrollment across all programs.

6. Disclosure

Instructors are required to disclose any actual or potential conflict of interest to the Program Director for review and discussion.

7. Enforcement

Violation of this agreement may result in disciplinary action up to and including termination.
