## SCHOOL/COMMUNITY

Nauset Regional High School is a public, four year comprehensive high school accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges. The current high school enrollment is approximately 730 students, grades nine through twelve, from a four town region (Brewster, Eastham, Orleans and Wellfleet and tuition students from Provincetown and Truro). The 72 acre campus is situated in the heart of the National Seashore Park in North Eastham, MA. Currently undergoing a rebuild/renovation project, the school is uniquely designed with several modern buildings around an open courtyard.

## CURRICULUM

- **Advanced Placement (16)**  
Nauset Regional High School offers Approved Advanced Placement (AP) courses in Calculus (AB), Statistics, English Literature and English Language, U.S. History, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Environmental Science, Computer Science, Spanish, French, U. S. Government, Art History, Economics, Music Theory, and Psychology
- **International Baccalaureate (3)**  
The International Baccalaureate program is being phased out. Very limited course offerings are available to students in the class of 2026 only. The only coursework currently being offered is English, Spanish, and French
- **Honors**  
Honors courses are offered in the departments of English, Math, Science, Social Studies, World Language, Business and Music.
- **College Preparatory**  
College Preparatory courses provide academic preparation at a level acceptable to any institution of higher learning, including those with exceptional standards. These courses are offered in every discipline and in grades nine through twelve.

The daily schedule consists of four class periods per day, seven classes total, all 85 minutes in length. All students are required to take seven courses with no study halls. Classes meet in a waterfall schedule.
