

Chartiers-Houston High School Parking Pass Application



Student Driving and Parking Regulations

- All vehicles parked on Chartiers-Houston High School property must be registered and display a valid Chartiers-Houston High School issued parking pass.
- Student drivers must adhere to all driving rules and regulations.
- Reckless driving, speeding, and/or discourteous behavior involving private vehicles while on school premises is prohibited.
- Students are not permitted to drive more than 5 mph on school property.
- Students are only permitted to park in their assigned parking space.
- Student drivers must hold a valid driver's license, registration, and insurance on the vehicle.
- Students driving to WACTC must have a WACTC issued parking pass.
- Violation of the Code of Conduct and/or student driving regulations may result in revocation of the parking pass.
- Parking passes are not to be shared with other drivers and are non-transferable.
- Motorcycles are prohibited on school property.
- The district shall not be responsible for motor vehicles or contents within those that are lost, stolen, damaged, or for injuries arising from their use.
- Students are not permitted to transport other students without written permission from both the parent(s) of the driver and passenger(s).
- Students who have parking passes revoked or do not have a Chartiers-Houston High School issued parking pass, may have their vehicle towed at the owner's expense.
- All vehicles parked on school property are subject to search if there is reasonable suspicion that the vehicle contains items or substances that violate school policies, the Student Code of Conduct, pose a threat to the safety of students or staff, or are illegal. By bringing a vehicle onto school grounds, students acknowledge and consent to such searches in accordance with school district policy.
- Parking is limited and therefore application completion does not guarantee receipt of a pass.
- The parking permit application requires a \$20.00 fee payable by cash, check, or money order to Chartiers-Houston School District. Sophomores approved to park in the township gravel lot have a \$10 fee. The fee is returned if the application is not approved.
- A \$10.00 fee is charged for any unreturned, lost, damaged or stolen parking passes.
