Once again, the Overton County School system is participating in the Seamless Summer Option (SSO), made available to schools through the USDA. This year's logo is "Summer Nutrition Programs for Kids" or "SUN" and is available, at no cost, to all kids eighteen years old and under. Most students participate in the school meal program, provided by the USDA during the school year. However, many students are left without meals during the summer months while school is not in session. The SSO/SUN program strives to alleviate childhood hunger by providing meals during the summer months while normal school attendance is not mandatory.

To participate in the SSO/SUN program, please provide the required information below, so that we can purchase the amount of food needed for the number of children in the household and/or number of days meals requested. This information is also needed for the USDA reimbursement of costs to the School Nutrition Program for hosting the SSO/SUN.

Please return this application as soon as possible so that the cafeteria staff can have meals packaged, and ready for distribution. Summer Camp students can receive meals for 3 days (Friday, Saturday, and Sunday) **beginning June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2026**. Thank you.
