**The Meade County Board of Education met at Stuart Pepper Middle School, Brandenburg, Kentucky, at 6:00 p.m., on the tenth of June, 2025, with the following members present: Steve Orr, Nathan Beavin, Alison Allen, Sandy Smith and Dana Flaherty.**

**The meeting was called to order by Sandy Smith and the following business was transacted:**

Good News in the Greenwave Nation:

The meeting was opened up with the end of year highlight video followed by Dr. Martin's recognition of the retirement of two district administrators, Amy Berry and Glen Wilson.

The Meade County High School Baseball team was recognized for their regional championship. This is the third regional championship in the team's history.

### **135 Construction Update**

Kenny Stanfield, Sherman Carter Barnhart Architect, presented an update to the Board on the Meade County High School Addition/Renovation. He reviewed the recent bid process along with the alternates and base bid information. He also reviewed the roofing contract with Insulated Roofing Contractors. Mr. Stanfield commented that July 1, 2028 is the substantial completion date for the project.

### **136 Approval of Bid for Meade County High School Addition/Renovation**

After the review of the bid information by Kenny Stanfield, it was moved by Nathan Beavin with a second by Dana Flaherty to approve the Bid and all Alternates submitted by Redlee Construction in the amount of \$45,708,000.00 and the contract with Insulated Roofing Contractors for the roof portion of the project for \$2,500,000.00 upon KDE approval.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MEADE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT FINANCE CORPORATION, RELATING TO AND PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF \$50,570,000 PRINCIPAL AMOUNT (SUBJECT TO A PERMITTED ADJUSTMENT OF \$5,055,000) OF SPECIAL OBLIGATION BONDS (SCHOOL BUILDING REVENUE BONDS) IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTIONS 58.180 AND 162.120 THROUGH 162.290 AND 162.385 OF THE KENTUCKY REVISED STATUTES TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR SCHOOL BUILDING PURPOSES, PROVIDING AND DETERMINING THE DUTY OF SAID CORPORATION IN CONNECTION WITH THE OPERATION OF THE SCHOOL PROPERTY, THE CREATION OF FUNDS SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SAID REVENUE BONDS AS AND WHEN THEY MATURE, THE CREATION OF ADEQUATE MAINTENANCE AND INSURANCE FUNDS, AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF CONTINUING DISCLOSURE PROCEDURES AND THE EXECUTION OF TAX COMPLIANCE PROCEDURES, AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION
