The Meade County Board of Education met at Stuart Pepper Middle School, Brandenburg, Kentucky, at 6:00 p.m., on the tenth of June, 2025, with the following members present: Steve Orr, Nathan Beavin, Alison Allen, Sandy Smith and Dana Flaherty.

The meeting was called to order by Sandy Smith and the following business was transacted:

Good News in the Greenwave Nation:

The meeting was opened up with the end of year highlight video followed by Dr. Martin's recognition of the retirement of two district administrators, Amy Berry and Glen Wilson.

The Meade County High School Baseball team was recognized for their regional championship. This is the third regional championship in the team's history.

135 ConstructionUpdate

Kenny Stanfield, Sherman Carter Barnhart Architect, presented an update to the Board on the Meade County High School Addition/Renovation. He reviewed the recent bid process along with the alternates and base bid information. He also reviewed the roofing contract with Insulated Roofing Contractors. Mr. Stanfield commented that July 1, 2028 is the substantial completion date for the project.

136 Approval of Bid for Meade County High School Addition/Renovation
