🔬 Earth & Environmental Science

- Pen/pencil

🔬 Chemistry / Physical Science

- 2-inch or larger three-ring binder
- Scientific or graphic calculator
- #2 pencils
- Colored pencils
- 5 page protectors
- 6 dividers
- Loose-leaf paper (as needed)

+ Foundations of Math / Math 1

- 2-inch binder (only for this class)
- Loose-leaf paper (college or wide ruled)
- Pencils (with erasers)

- 3-inch binder (minimum)
- College-ruled notebook paper
- Pencils (and erasers)

<u>é</u> English I

- ½ to 1-inch three-ring binder
- 7 dividers
- Pencils, pens, and highlighters
- Highlighter colors: yellow, orange, pink, blue, green, purple
- College-ruled notebook paper
- Standard-size sticky notes (light colors, 3x3)

<u>é</u> English II

- Colored highlighters
- Pencils
- Colored pens (not black) for self-grading
- 3-5 subject notebook (reuse from previous year is fine)
- Folder
- Sticky notes

<u>é</u> English III & IV

- Blue or black pens (required for written assignments)
- Pencils (#2 or mechanical)
- Whiteout or whiteout tape
- At least 3 colored highlighters
- Medium permanent markers
- Colored pens/fine liners (for editing/annotating)
- Sticky tab flags
- Personal mini stapler
- Glue sticks
- Thick journal-style notebook (used daily)
- Spiral notebook (notes, vocabulary, etc.)
- College-ruled loose-leaf notebook paper (100 sheets)
- 1-1.5 inch ring binder with dividers
- Packet of white cardstock
