



Career and Technical Education, more fondly referred to as CTE by Conroe ISD students, focuses on preparing students for current in-demand jobs. Tally Jo Stout, Director of CTE, stated that the program's mission is to "offer access to career and skills-based instruction and industry certification, preparing students with the knowledge and flexibility essential to succeed in the rapidly changing world of future careers."

For many students, one of the most attractive aspects of CTE courses is the opportunity to apply skills and knowledge in real world situations.

CTE students engage directly with industry-standard equipment and technology. This exposure to professional-grade tools and systems enables CISD students to develop practical skills while working on authentic projects that mirror real workplace scenarios in their chosen career fields.

Conroe ISD residents age 65 and over qualify for the **over 65 exemption** effective January 1 of any year in which he or she turns 65 or purchases a residence after they are already 65 or older. CISD

CANEY

exempts an additional \$15,000 of the assessed value and places a freeze ceiling on the district tax amount for qualifying individuals.
