CAUCUS MEETING MINUTES

May 4, 2026

The Meeting was called to order by Mayor Brandley.

The flag salute was led by Mayor Brandley.

Mayor Brandley announced that the meeting was in compliance with the Sunshine Law.

Council Persons present: MacGregor, Cairns Wright and Angelucci. Councilman Jordan and Councilwoman Valianti were not present.

Council went over the Engineer's report with Shawn Seroka from Key Engineers.

Council went over the tentative agenda for the Council Meeting.

Discussion Items:

Fitness Court-Council discussed adding a fitness court at the new Recreation area at the former swim club site. Council decided to move forward with the project.

Event on Borough Property-Council approved an event at Memorial Park Parking lot on May 31, 2026 for the Civic Association.

Old Business-

Updating Upcoming Events on Calendar/App- Reminder to forward all town events and app.

Councilman Angelucci made a motion to open the meeting to the public, seconded by Council President MacGregor. All in favor-motion carried.

Lois Giovacchini-5 Laurie Lane-Concerned about the tree boxes on W. Clinton Ave. Does not feel large trees can be planted there. She is also concerned that the Shade Tree Committee was not informed of this. Councilman Angelucci addressed her concerns and said that the plan was discussed at the last Shade Tree Committee meeting.

David Hasner-16 Newton Ave.-Agrees with Ms. Giovacchini's concerns and also with PSE & G cutting down and trimming trees in town.

Matt Grochowski-208 Manheim Ave.-Oaklyn has been designated as a "Tree City USA". The Borough received a plaque and signs to be hung around town. Also, a flag that is flying at the former library building. The Green Team's "No Moe May" is underway.

Woody Wright-117 W. Holly Ave.-Is concerned about the condition of the basketball court behind the school. It needs to be fixed so kids can play there. Mayor Brandley explained that a new basketball court is being built at the new Recreation area.

David Galpern-128 Woodland Terr-Asked if Council has considered passing a resolution like other towns in Camden County banning ICE to enter their facilities? Mayor Brandley said that he is looking into that.

Chelsea Gittle-45 E. Bettewood Ave.- Asked about the sign ordinance amendments that will be introduced at the Council meeting. Council President MacGregor said that she plans to attend the Planning Board meeting this month to ask the questions she has.

Being there was no further discussion, Council President MacGregor made a motion to close the meeting to the public, seconded by Councilwoman Cairns. All in favor-motion carried.
