CAUCUS MEETING MINUTES

April 6, 2026

The Meeting was called to order by Mayor Brandley.

The flag salute was led by Mayor Brandley.

Mayor Brandley announced that the meeting was in compliance with the Sunshine Law.

Council Persons present: Jordan, MacGregor and Valianti. Councilman Wright, Councilman Angelucci and Councilwoman Cairns were not present.

Council went over the Engineer's report with Shawn Seroka from Key Engineers.

Council went over the tentative agenda for the Council Meeting.

Discussion Items:

Planning Board-Master Plan Re-examination-The Planning Board asked Mayor and Council to review the Stormwater Ordinance. Key Engineers will take a look at the revisions needed.

Planning Board-Proposed Revisions to Sign Ordinance-The Planning Board presented Mayor and Council with proposed changes to the Sign Ordinance. Mayor and Council will look at the changes and will address them in May.

Ridgeway Ave. Sanitary Sewer-Key Engineers did a cost estimate for the Ridgeway Ave. sanitary sewer reconstruction. It was determined that the Public Works Department can do the work to cut down some of the costs.

Old Business-

Updating Upcoming Events on Calendar/App- Reminder to forward all town events and app. The new alert system has over 500 residents signed up at this time.

Fire Department Presentation-The Fire Department presented plans for a new pump truck. It would be a 2026 model and could be delivered in February/March of 2027.

Council President MacGregor made a motion to open the meeting to the public, seconded by Councilman Jordan. All in favor-motion carried.

Chelsea Gittle-45 E. Bettleground Ave.-Suggested that the app be used to notify residents when the streets are going to be swept so residents can move the cars off the street. April is Green Month. The Green Team is having a Movie Night on April 17th at VFW Park. April 28th they will be holding a Tree Care Presentation at the Senior Center.
