CAUCUS MEETING MINUTES

June 1, 2026

The Meeting was called to order by Mayor Brandley.

The flag salute was led by Mayor Brandley.

Mayor Brandley announced that the meeting was in compliance with the Sunshine Law.

Council Persons present: MacGregor, Cairns Wright, Valianti and Jordan. Councilman Angelucci was not present.

Council went over the Engineer's report with Shawn Seroka from Key Engineers.

Ordinance 05-26-Amending Chapter 125 Discussion-Borough Administrator Bonnie Taft explain that there was some confusion about the amendments to this ordinance being discussed at the Planning Board meeting in May. She believed there would be a portion of the meeting for the public to comment. There was not. She apologized for the confusion but explained that there would be an opportunity for the public to comment tonight and also at the Council meeting on June 9th.
