COUNCIL MEETING

February 10, 2026

The Meeting was called to order by Mayor Brandley.

The flag salute was led by Mayor Brandley.

Mayor Brandley announced that the meeting was in compliance with the Sunshine Law.

Council Persons present: MacGregor, Cairns, Jordan, Wright, Angelucci and Valianti.

The minutes of the December 30th, 2025 Close-out meeting, January 5, 2026 Reorganization meeting, January 14, 2026 Budget meeting, January 28, 2026 Budget meeting and the February 2, 2026 Caucus meeting were approved by motion of Council President MacGregor, seconded by Councilman Jordan. All in favor-motion carried.

Treasurer's Report-Councilwoman Cairns read the January Treasurer's reports. Approved by motion of Councilman Angelucci, seconded by Council President MacGregor. Unanimous roll call vote.

PLANNING & ZONING- The School Board held their Reorganization meeting in January. Three new members were sworn in. Planning Board approved a variance at their January meeting. Nothing on the Agenda for the February meeting.
