February 3, 2025

Being there was no further discussion, Councilwoman Valianti made a motion to close the meeting to the public, seconded by Council President MacGregor. All in favor-motion carried.

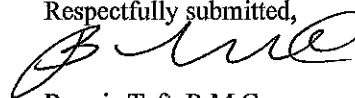
Council President MacGregor made a motion to go into closed session, seconded by Councilman Jordan. All in favor-motion carried.
