March 10, 2026

The Meeting was called to order by Mayor Brandley.

The flag salute was led by Mayor Brandley.

The minutes of the February 11, 2026 Council Meeting and the March 2, 2026 Caucus meeting were approved by motion of Councilwoman Cairns, seconded by Council President MacGregor. All in favor-motion carried.

Treasurer's Report-Councilwoman Cairns read the February Treasurer's reports. Approved by motion of Councilman Angelucci, seconded by Council President MacGregor. Unanimous roll call vote.

Being there was no further discussion, the meeting was closed to the public by motion of Council President MacGregor, seconded by Councilwoman Cairns. All in favor-motion carried.

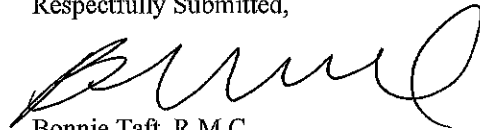
Council discussed the 2026 Budget.
