



# CHILD FIND NOTICE

Child Find is a component of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA '04) that requires Public Education Agencies (PEAs) to locate, identify, and evaluate all children (birth through 21 years old) with disabilities who reside within their boundaries.

TVUSD conducts screenings and evaluations for children on an as-needed basis in the following areas: vision, hearing, cognitive abilities, motor skills, speech and language, social-emotional skills, and self-help skills.

We especially encourage participation by children who have reached 2 years and 10.5 months, as every effort is made to provide needed services by the third birthday.

District residency verification is required before a screening can take place.
