Re: City Brush Site

**Issue:**

Ste. Genevieve Fire Protection District Chief Steiger has requested the City consider the following:

- Shut down the site
- Reduce size of wood chunks allowed or have a separate area for large chunks
- Ban commercial tree trimmers from using the site
- Make a larger berm around the site
- Haul away debris more often
- Burn in smaller piles
- Post site rules, replace cameras & increase enforcement

Recommendation:

Discuss. Continue with current plans.

We are currently working on the following:

- Ordering and posting the attached sign at the site.
- Ordering and placing two cameras at the site.
- Once sign & cameras are installed, increasing patrol & enforcement.
- Plans to haul away existing debris & ash this fall / early winter
- Improvements to berm and consideration of spark screen fence installation
- Plans to haul away debris annually after this year
