July 23, 2026

1. Jokerst Inc. continues to work on the second part of the water line on the southern or eastern half of LaHaye. They should be completing hot taps and testing this week with service line connections completed over the next 2 weeks.
2. Alliance has completed the installation of a new water line on N 6th. They are installing two new manholes this week and it will be ready for Bauman's to pave.
3. Bauman's has begun milling and paving on Riverview / Picardy / Crestview. They plan to move to Lahaye / N 6th after that.
4. We close on the subdivision property next week on the 29th.
5. The Sara's Garden project is complete except for some additional planting that the Master Gardener's will do this weekend along with the Rotary Club. We will also be adding some café lighting and will then schedule a ribbon cutting.
6. I will be out of the office next week, 6/26 – 7/2 on vacation but I am not leaving town. You can reach me via phone and email.

WATER TREATMENT

- Mule Hide did a roof inspection on the water plant roof and gave SRS a few things to do so we would have the full 10-year warranty. SRS already completed the list.
- The CO2 system went down and are waiting for the parts to be delivered so we can rebuild it.

WASTEWATER TREATMENT

- We replaced the bearing on the north rotor at the treatment plant. The old one failed.
- The tanker was sandblasted and painted before we did the tank swap.

WATER DISTRIBUTION

- We delivered door hangers on North 6th Street notifying the residents of the upcoming water line replacement project.
- The Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) was posted at city hall, and the residents were notified on their water bills.
- We did flushing throughout town with the sudden temperature change. The change causes the minerals inside the pipe to break free and results in dirty water.
- The hot taps on Jefferson and Washington Streets were made for the new water line installation down North 6th Street. This project also began.
- I did the Risk and Resiliency Assessment (RRA) and the Emergency Response Plan (ERP) for the EPA. Certificates were sent to them. This must be completed every 5 years.

SEWER COLLECTIONS

There were no sanitary sewer overflows (SSO) for the month.

- We had to pull pump #1 at lift station #1 due to high amps. A piece of clothing was removed from the impeller.
- We set the manhole lid on a new structure on North 6th Street. We had to pour it separately and then set it.

STREETS/STORM

- The banner poles were cut to size, powder coated and are back and we are awaiting the locations for them to be placed.
- The sidewalks by the Ferry Landing were broomed and washed to remove the dirt and gravel.
- We did the setup for the French Heritage Festival.
- We changed the pickup head on the sweeper. It made a big difference in the amount of debris it can now pick up.
- We did 7 tons of asphalt patching on Biltmore, 3rd, and Blain Streets.
- The boom mower was out several times hitting along the creeks and ditches.

PARKS

- The trail at Valle Springs Park was completed. We dug it out, put down edgers, and filled and rolled the screenings in.
- The story boards were set at Valle Springs Park.
- I did a walk through with David Bova and Chrissy from the park board to discuss the electricity that is going to be needed for their Christmas displays in the park.

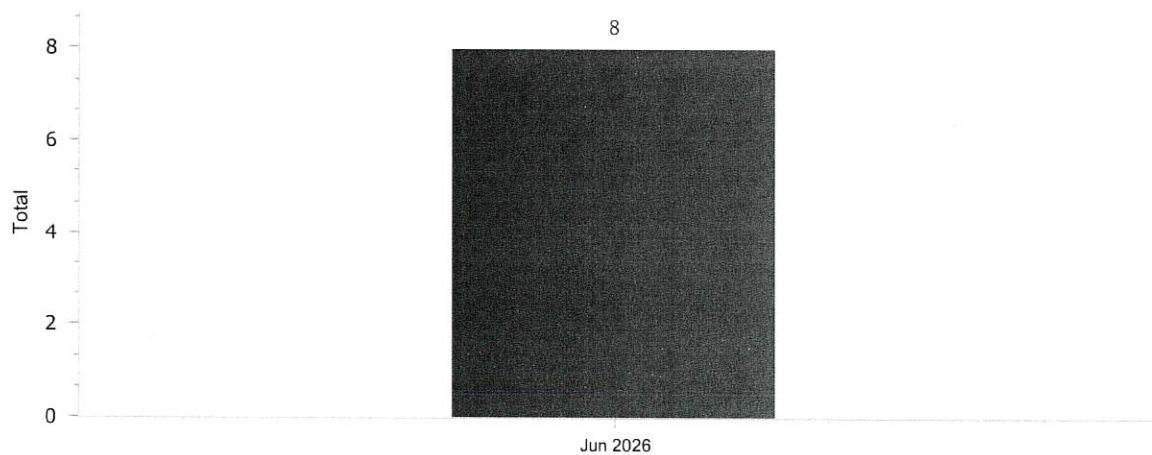

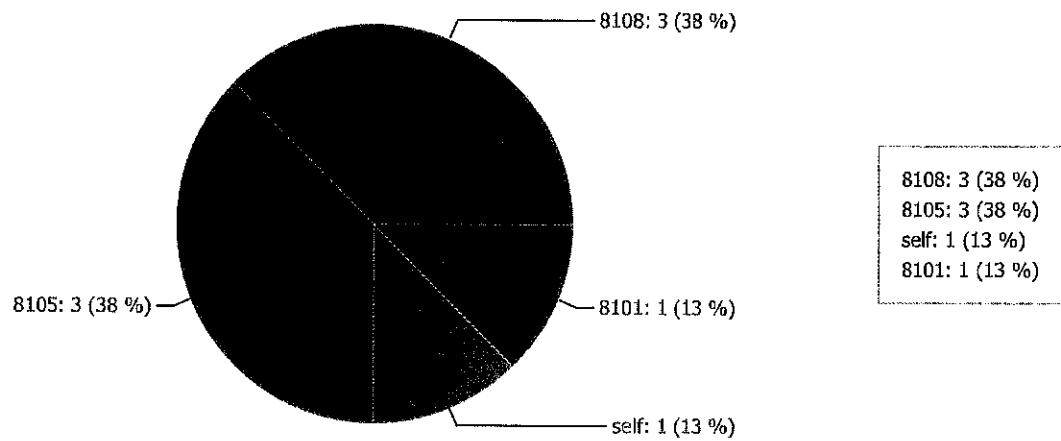

Demographic Data: Arrests

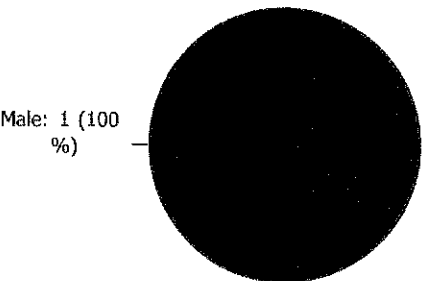
Arrests by Race/Ethnicity

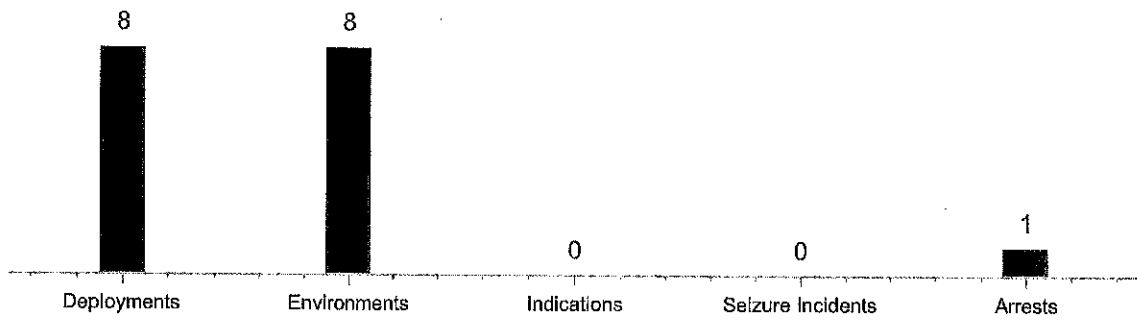

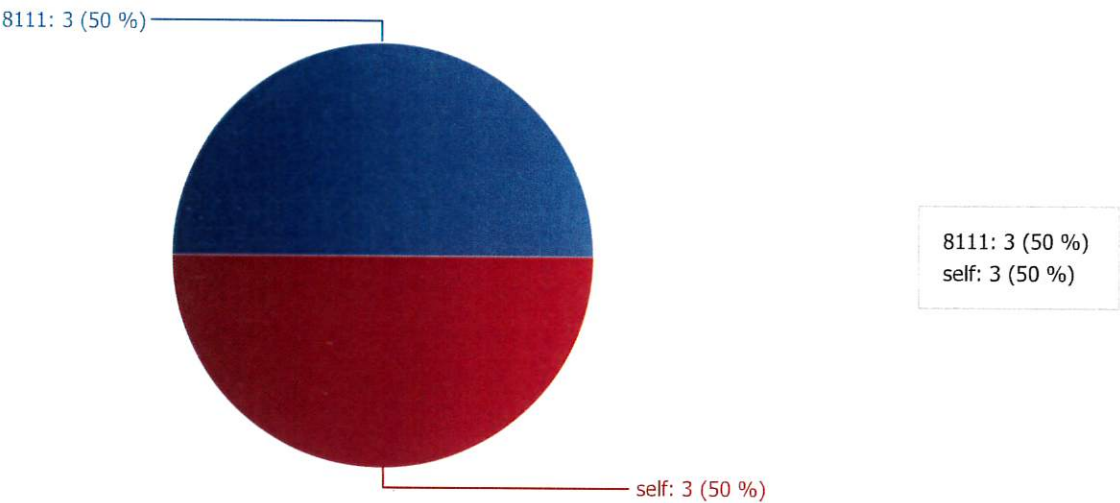

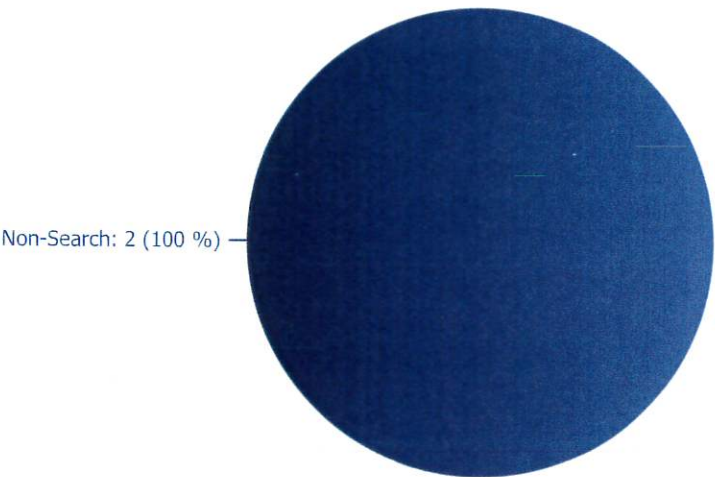

Patrol Types

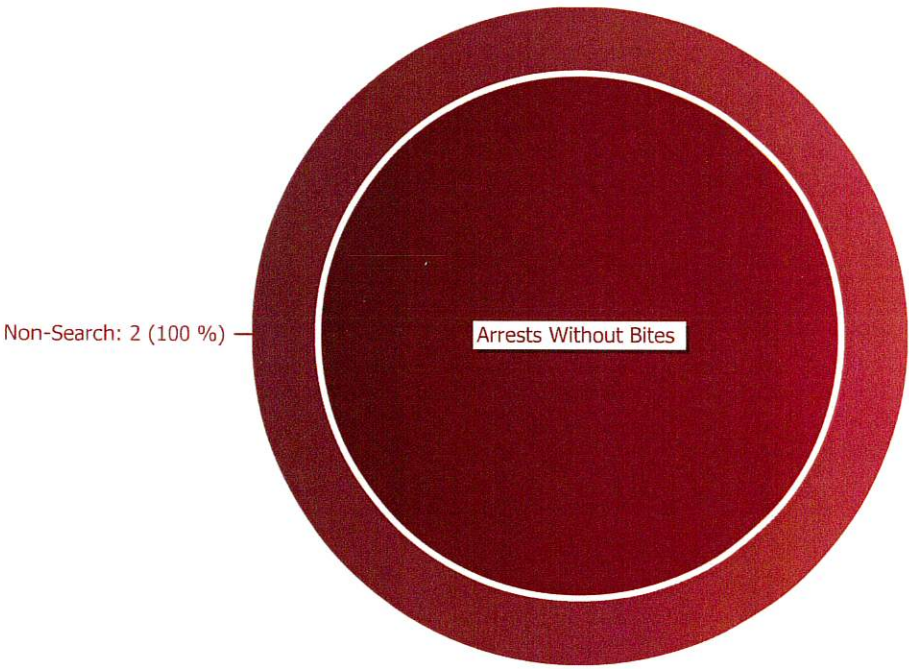

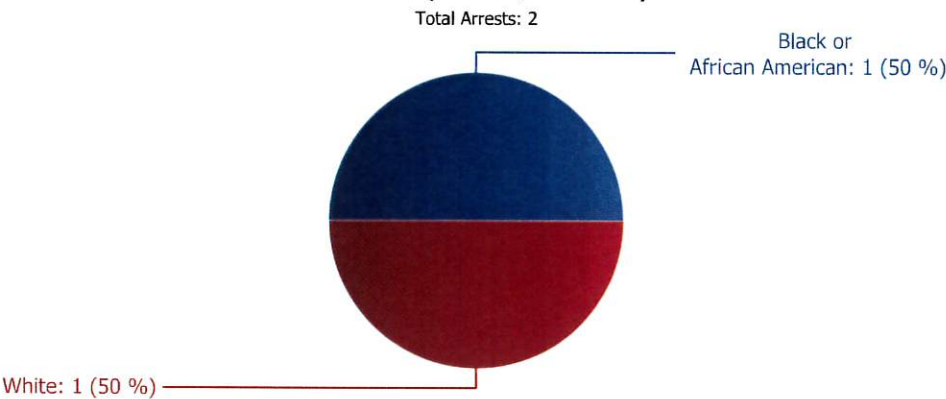

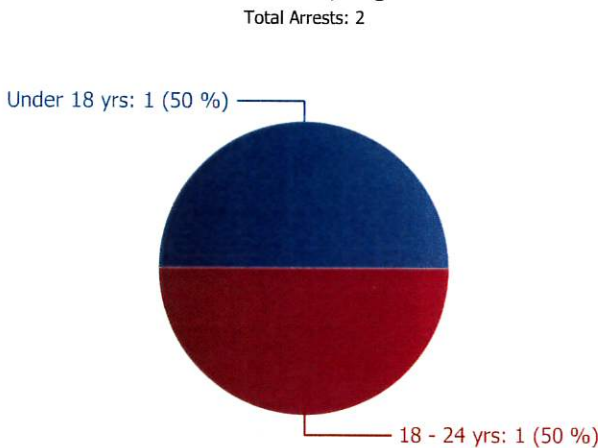

Demographic Data: Arrests

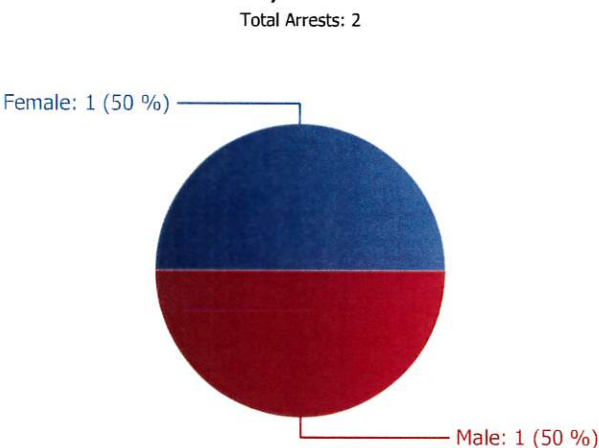
Arrests by Race/Ethnicity



Arrests by Age

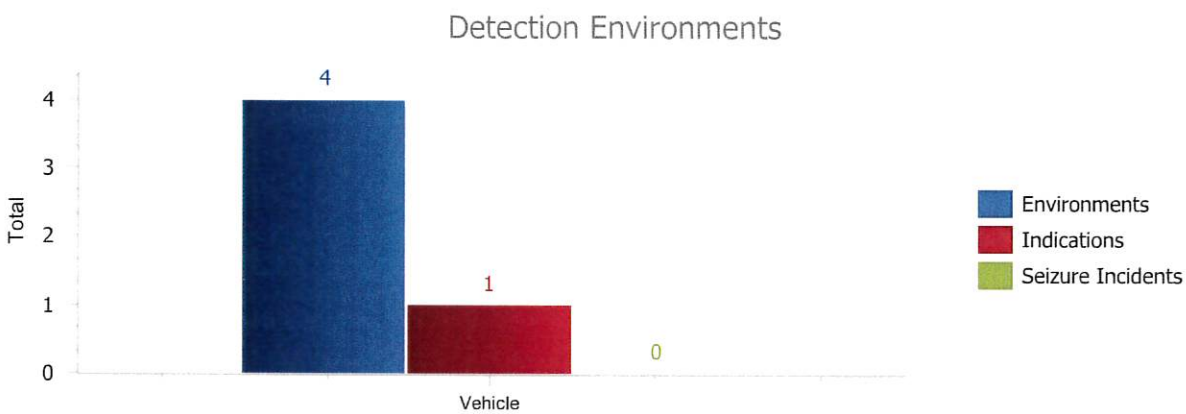
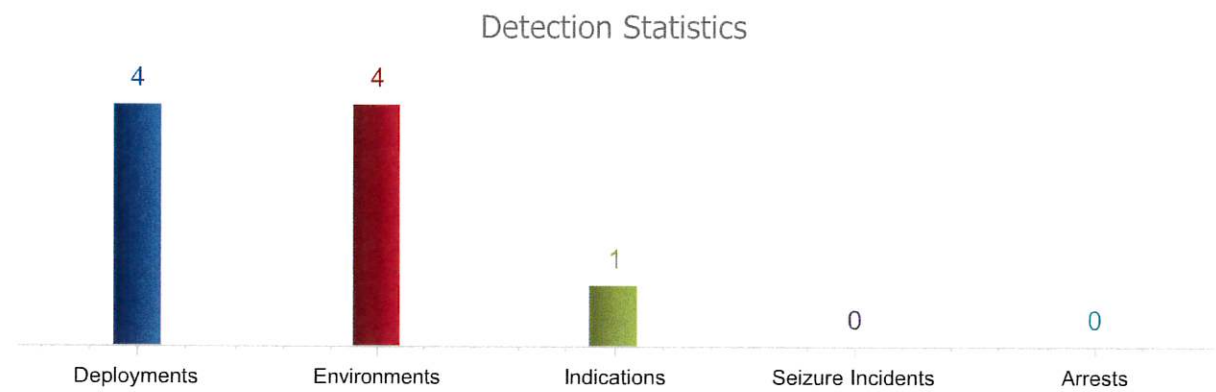


Arrests by Sex At Birth

CALL TO ORDER. Mayor Keim called the regular meeting of the Ste. Genevieve Board of Aldermen to order at 6:00 p.m. and all stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA. A motion by Alderman Eydmann, second by Alderman Ross to approve the amended agenda as presented. Motion carried 6-0-2 with Alderman Prince and Alderwoman Dobbs absent.

PERSONAL APPEARANCE.

Chief Kenny Steiger with the Ste. Genevieve Fire District updated the Mayor and Board of Aldermen with the fire district.

At this time Willows Nest Domestic Violence Shelter executive director Kathy Kreitler introduced herself along with County Prosecuting Attorney Wayne Williams and Board President Mr. Doug Burris. They explained their new approach on how domestic violence cases and answered any questions the Board members had.

Josh Wright - Prosperite Sainte Genevieve introduced himself to the Mayor and Board would like to offer the City of Ste. Genevieve. Mr. Wright explained that Prosperite Sainte Genevieve was organized to engage in historic preservation activities, economic development, and revitalization education in Ste. Genevieve, Missouri, with their main goal being to make the community more marketable.

Ernie Kovac – Mr. Kovac stated that big trucks are still being routed the wrong way. Mr. Kovac asked if signs could be installed. Mr. Kovac also spoke on the trash survey that is currently be conducted and voiced his opinion that an ordinance should be adopted that would limit the weight of all trash trucks. Mr. Kovac asked about how to obtain a phone number for ethics of an election and reminded everyone about the Muny Band Concerts.

Guy Luttrell – 399 N. Main Street – Mr. Luttrell spoke about the trash survey and how a lot of the older residents only have one bag of trash. Mr. Luttrell also asked about the City Building Inspector and what kind of qualifications are required for this job position.

Jerry Klein – 699 LaPorte Street – Mr. Klein would like to see the City offer some type of recycling services since the trash company no longer offers the program.

Terry Sue Sheehan voiced her opinion regarding civil rights lawsuits.

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 210 OFFENSES OF THE STE. GENEVIEVE CODE OF ORDINANCES AS SET FORTH BELOW:

WHEREAS, the City of Ste. Genevieve has a need to amend Article VII of Chapter 210 of the Offenses Ordinance regarding the use of city symbols, insignia, seals and logos; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen believe it to be in best interest of the City to approve this amendment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF STE. GENEVIEVE, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 210.395 Unauthorized Use of Any Symbol, Insignia, Seal or Logo of the City is added to Chapter 210, Article VII as follows:

Section 210.395 Unauthorized Use of Any Symbol, Insignia, Seal or Logo of the City.

Unless expressly otherwise authorized in writing signed by the city administrator or his designee, no person shall use any symbol, insignia, seal or logo of the city or any department thereof or related governmental body or agency (herein collectively the "city") except in connection with the business of the city, and specifically no person shall:

- (1) Use any reproduction, counterfeit, copy, or colorable imitation of any such seal or logo in connection with the sale, offering for sale, or advertising of any goods or services other than those of the city; or
- (2) Reproduce, counterfeit, copy or colorably imitate any such seal or logo and apply such reproduction, counterfeit, copy or colorable imitation to labels, signs, prints, packages, wrappers, receptacles, or advertisements intended to be used upon or in conjunction with the sale or other distribution of goods or services other than those of the city.

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

Section 3. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence or provision of this ordinance shall be given effect without such invalid part or parts.
