







# CARRIDERS/WALKERS CARRIDER TAG

- If you do not have car rider tag, you will be asked to park and walk in to show ID.
- Walkers/Bike Riders: During inclement weather all walkers/riders will need to be picked up using the car rider line.
- Please STAY IN YOUR VEHICLE.



# Dismissal





 Parents must use car rider line during arrival and dismissal. Parents should only park and walk their child into the school if they have official business inside the building.



• If a student is a walker, the student's primary address in Focus must be within 2- miles per Florida Statute. (Section 1011.68, F.S.)



 Students strongly encouraged not to ride electric scooters to school. Riders must wear helmet and motor must be less than 750 watts. (Section 316. 2128, F.S.)












## ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS FOR MIDDLE SCHOOL

Based on Florida Statute 1003.4156 that was put into law in 2006, students must successfully complete the following academic courses in order to be promoted to 9th grade.





- THREE (3) MIDDLE SCHOOL OR HIGHER COURSES IN ENGLISH (ELA)
- THREE (3) MIDDLE SCHOOL OR HIGHER COURSES IN MATH.
- THREE (3) MIDDLE SCHOOL OR HIGHER COURSES IN SOCIAL STUDIES.
- THREE (3) MIDDLE SCHOOL OR HIGHER COURSES IN SCIENCE.
- ONE (1) CLASS PERIOD EQUIVALENT FOR ONE (1) SEMESTER FOR EACH YEAR ENROLLED IN MIDDLE SCHOOL PHYSICAL EDUCATION. (UNLESS A WAIVER HAS BEEN ISSUED)




## **CDAC Behavioral Healthcare**


All students are required to have a signed AUP (acceptable use policy) agreement on file in order to utilize district technology



- 5 No clothing with adult or suggestive brands or phrases.




