MINUTES

1. Call to Order, roll call, establish a quorum.
Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were Council members Carr, Bowie Williams, Foster, and Thompson. A quorum was present.
2. Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance
Invocation given by Councilman Williams, Pledge of Allegiance led by Chief McCrary.
3. Judge Stephen Young to deliver the Oath of Office to elected Council members; Shaka Bowie – Place 2, Steve Williams – Place 3, and Ron Humphrey – Mayor.
Judge Young administered the oath of office to Council members Shaka Bowie, Steve Williams, and Ron Humphrey.
4. Mayor Ron Humphrey to deliver the Oath of Office to Judge Stephen Young
Mayor Humphrey administered the oath of office to Judge Young.
5. Lee Elliot, SIDC Director to provide the City Council with project updates for both SIDC and CDC.
Director Elliot conveyed his appreciation to the Council for their efforts and encouraging them to continue to move forward. He also acknowledged Council member Bowie for her efforts in trying to facilitate an ER Clinic for New Boston. "Notice to Proceed" regarding Eaves property, the downtown committee has ordered new trash cans for downtown and additional benches for the park. For the fiscal year budget 2027 he is proposing two ground mounted gateway signs coming into New Boston one on the east side of I-30 and one on the west side of I-30. Addition funds have been budgets for Tapp and Scrap Miller parks.
6. Public Comments

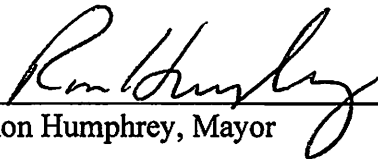

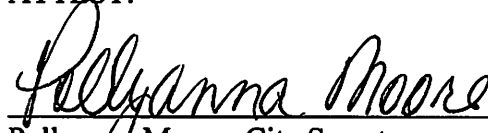
Motion made by Council member Carr to approve consent agenda as presented. Motion seconded by Council member Bowie. All voted in favor of, motion carried.
