

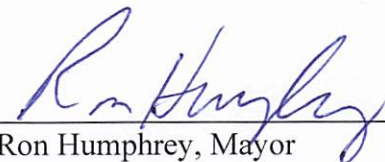


Special Council Meeting

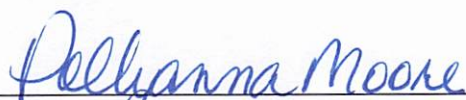
AGENDA

1. Call to Order, roll call, establish a quorum.
Mayor Humphrey called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were council members Carr, Bowie, Williams, and Thompson. A quorum was established.
2. Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance
Mayor Humphrey led Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Consider and take official action to close College Street and allow the NBISD to install gates to keep traffic out. The street runs north to south between the High School and the Continuing Education Center. There are no residential homes on this street.
Motion made by council member Carr in favor of closing College Street to pass through traffic for the safety of students crossing the street from one building to another. Motion seconded by council member Bowie. All voted in favor of, motion carried.
4. Consider and take official action to hire a consulting firm to provide administrative services for the city's application to the 2025 Downtown Revitalization Program from the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program of the Texas Department of Agriculture.
Motion made by council member Carr to hire KBB Consulting, LLC to provide administrative services for the Downtown Revitalization Program. Motion seconded by council member Bowie. All voted in favor of, motion carried.
5. Adjourn.
Motion made by council member Bowie to adjourn. Motion seconded by council member Williams. All voted in favor of, motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:07 p.m.
