Consider and take official action to adopt Ordinance 25-O-03 – **AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF NEW BOSTON, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2025, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2026; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR EACH DEPARTMENT, AND ACCOUNT; PROVIDING FOR NECESSARY TRANSFERS OF FUNDS BETWEEN ACCOUNTS AND DEPARTMENTS, IF REQUIRED, PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, SAVINGS CLAUSE, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

Consider and take official action to adopt Ordinance 25-O-04 - **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEW BOSTON, TEXAS ADOPTING AND LEVYING THE MUNICIPAL AD VOLOREM TAX FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2025 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2026 ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF NEW BOSTON, AS OF JANUARY 1, 2026, PROVIDING REVENUES FOR PAYMENT OF CURRENT EXPENSES AND OUTSTANDING DEBTS OF THE CITY; DIRECTING THE ASSESSMENT THEREOF; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**
