MINUTES

1. Call to Order, roll call, establish a quorum.

Mayor Humphrey called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Council members Carr, Bowie, Williams, Thompson, and Laney were present. A quorum was established.

2. Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance

Invocation given by Judge Stephen Young. Pledge of Allegiance led by Chief McCrary.

3. Public Comments

Pursuant to Government regulations the Mayor and City Council are not permitted to comment or engage in discussions on non-agenda items. For non-agenda items - Each speaker will be given 3 minutes, not to exceed a total allotted time of fifteen minutes. For agenda items - Speakers will be given 3 minutes each.

Motion made by Council member Bowie to accept the consent agenda as presented. Motion seconded by Council member Carr. All voted in favor of, motion carried.

5. Mayor's comments

Mayor Humphrey honored Councilman Laney with a plaque from the City of New Boston for his decades of dedicated service to the community, fire department and City Council.

6. Judge Stephen Young to deliver the Oath of Office to newly elected Council members; Rob Carr – Place 1, Michael Foster – Place 4, and Jeffery Thompson – Place 5.

Judge Young gave the Oath of Office to Rob Carr, Michael Foster and Jeffery Thompson and had elected officials sign a Statement of Officer. Newly elected Council Member Foster took his seat.

7. Consider and take action to elect a Mayor Pro-Tempore.

Council member Bowie made a motion to elect a council member as the Mayor Pro-Tem. Council member Williams nominated Robb Carr. Council member Bowie seconded the motion to elect Council member Carr as Mayor Pro-Tempore. Each individual council member made a verbal vote and was recorded by City Secretary, Pollyanna Moore. Council Members Carr, Bowie, Williams, and Thompson voted in favor of. Council member Foster voted against

electing Rob Carr as Mayor Pro-Tem. Motion passed with 4 votes in favor of electing Rob Carr as Mayor Pro-Tem for a period of one year.

8. Consider and take action to adopt Resolution 25-R-03, **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW BOSTON, TEXAS, URGING CONGRESSIONAL SUPPORT FOR RED RIVER ARMY DEPOT (RRAD); AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

Council member Bowie made a motion to adopt Resolution 25-R-03. Motion seconded by Council member Carr. The floor was open for discussion. Council member Foster asked if there would be any monetary contribution from the city. The Mayor stated not at this time. This is strictly a resolution showing the City's support of Red River Army Depot. All voted in favor of, motion carried.

9. Chief McCrary to present Officer Russell Anderson with Official Commendation.
City Secretary, Pollyanna Moore read the official commendation aloud. Chief McCrary presented Officer Anderson with the official commendation and plaque.

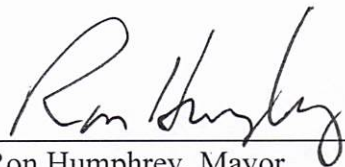
10. Mayor Ron Humphrey to make an appointment of Kayla Simmons to the Hotel/Motel Committee.

11. Adjourn.

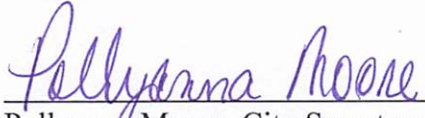
