3. Consider and take official action to approve annexation of the following three parcels of properties;

Blk/Tract 25, 18.972 acres. Property owned by Kyle Davis north of I-30
 - 3) Bowie County Parcel ID 26140002000 – WF Thompson A=565, 4426/162 09/30/04
blk/Tract 18, 65.328/acres. Property owned by Kyle Davis north of I-30

Consider and take official action to adopt Ordinance 24-O-08 - **AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING THE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBE TERRITORIES TO THE CITY OF NEW BOSTON, BOWIE COUNTY, TEXAS, AND EXTENDING THE BOUNDARY LIMITS OF SAID CITY SO AS TO INCLUDE SAID HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED PROPERTY WITHIN SAID CITY LIMITS, AND GRANTING TO ALL THE INHABITANTS OF SAID PROPERTY ALL THE RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF OTHER CITIZENS AND BINDING SAID INHABITANTS BY ALL OF THE ACTS, ORDINANCES, RESOLUTIONS, AND REGULATIONS OF SAID CITY; AND ADOPTING A SERVICE PLAN OR AGREEMENT.**
