A message from the City Manager, Bobbie Beshara:

Welcome to the City of Rittman! Rittman was settled in 1817 and incorporated as a city in 1911. Rittman is a Council-Manager form of government. The mayor presides over Council meetings and serves as a ceremonial mayor. We have a full-time Police Department and a part time Fire Department with a full-time Fire Chief.

The city has many beautiful parks which are run by our Parks and Recreation Department. Our newest park is the William J. Robertson Nature Preserve on Morningstar Drive. Purchased through a Clean Ohio grant, it features a handicap accessible kayak launch, a science center, a pavilion for picnics, boardwalks, etc. to enjoy viewing nature.

Your City of Rittman bill covers water, sewer, storm sewer, and trash (refuse).

Water Services

Water is billed one full month behind and is due on the 10th of the month, or the next business day. When starting new water services, you must be active for thirty (30) days before you receive your first bill. Tenants/Renters will need to pay a \$150 deposit to have the service in their name; Those funds will be held and applied to the final bill when the services are closed.

Trash (Refuse) and Recycling through Kimble Services

Refuse and recycling is picked up weekly, typically on Tuesdays, from your tree lawn. (If you live in an apartment, check with your landlord for trash disposal procedures). The dark green can is for trash and the bright green can is for recycling; they are barcoded directly to your property; if you do not see them, please contact your realtor/title company/landlord.

Kimble will allow ten (10) bags of trash and **one** bulk item per week. Furniture with cushions or bedding (mattresses, box springs) need to be wrapped in plastic, with the plastic taped shut. No need to call ahead. They do not accept any construction materials outside of your cans.

Payment Options

The Utilities Department accepts the following payment types: Bank check, Cash, Credit card, or Money Order. There is a drive thru drop box on the East side of the building, in the brick wall.

You can also sign up for ACH, where the monthly bill amount comes out of your bank account automatically each month. You will receive a bill as normal so that you know how much will come out of your account on the due date. Just fill out the [ACH form \(PDF\)](#) form and return to the office or email to utilities@rittman.com. There is **no** fee for this service.

Third party payment options (e-check and credit/debit card) are through NexBillPay via online (www.rittman.com) and toll free number 1-866-584-3770. Fees apply for **all** NexBillPay payments.

Check the back of your Utilities bill for Important City updates and events!

Parking is not allowed on Rittman streets between 1 a.m. and 6 a.m.

If you have an overnight visitor, or just need to park in the street for a night, please call the Police Department non-emergency number at 330-925-8040

City Brush pick up the first Wednesday of April annually. Additional pick ups available for \$20, paid at the Administration Building.

Free leaf pick up in the fall on a rotating days, check the back of your water bill for schedule.

Zoning permits are needed for fences, decks, swimming pools, additions/sheds, etc.

Contractors living outside of Rittman need a business license.
