*These items will be held for your child and given out as needed.

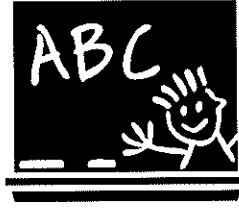
Space inside the desks is tight so kindly send only the listed items.

First Grade Supply List:

~1~ pair of kid sized headphones. (First graders tend to do better with headphones over ear buds.) Make sure to label them with your child's name or put them in a Ziploc bag with your child's name.



~5~ 24 pack boxes of Crayola Brand Crayons. (Crayola crayons last the longest.)



~1~ pack of 10 Crayola Fine Line Markers (Classic Colors)

~8~ (or more) BLACK, Fine Tip EXPO Dry Erase Markers (skinny ones) These are used every day and we go through a lot! EXPO brand lasts the longest and does not stain the boards.



~1~ (or more) Large Pink Eraser



~1~ Box of Tissues (any brand)

8	Expo BLACK, Fine Tip Dry Erase Markers (skinny ones)
3	Elmer's BIG glue stick (.77 oz)
1	pink rubber eraser
1	box of tissues
1	pack of baby wipes
1	box of gallon size ziplocs
1	Headphones for iPad with a cord (no earbuds please!)

1	Pocket Folder – 2 pockets going straight across horizontally / not diagonally. *Please put child's first and last name on the front of the folder.*
1	Backpack- big enough to fit a folder and lunch box (No wheels please!)
