Students need to provide the following information to obtain a parking pass:

1. Current School Schedule (will be provided at registration)
2. Current Driver's License
3. Proof of Insurance
4. Vehicle Registration
5. Signed Parking Permit Application
6. Signed Drug Consent Form
7. Baker Registration fee must be paid prior to purchasing a parking permit.
8. \$75 fee (If paying with check, make payable to Baker High School- include your phone number on check.)

Student driving and parking regulations are stated on this form. You must read and acknowledge understanding of the rules before receiving a parking permit. Parking is a privilege not a guarantee. Violations of parking regulations can result in a parking fine, towing of the vehicle at the owner's expense, loss of driving privileges, referral for disciplinary action, or suspension from school.

STUDENT DRIVING AND PARKING REGULATIONS

- All student vehicles must be registered with the school and display the current parking permit.
- All student vehicles must exercise safe driving practices, remembering that pedestrians have the right of way.
- All student vehicles must park only in their assigned numbered spot. Park in one space only, between the lines.
- When arriving or departing the parking lots, students must follow the one-way direction of traffic.
- After parking, students must leave the parking lots. No loitering.
- Upon arriving at school, students that drive cannot depart without permission.
- The school is not responsible for the vehicle or its contents.
- The owner of the vehicle is responsible for maintaining auto insurance as required by state law.
- In the event of an accident on campus, the owners are responsible for calling the police and obtaining an accident report.
- Student vehicles are subject to search if there is a reasonable ground to believe drugs, alcohol, weapons, stolen property, or other contraband might be present in the vehicle.
- No smoking on campus including inside of vehicles.
- Any student that withdraws from school must return their parking permit as part of the check-out process for withdrawal.
- Seniors are required to turn in their parking permit as part of the check-out process for graduation.
- Replacement of lost or stolen parking permits will cost \$45.00.
- Parking permits are to be used for the vehicle registered only and are nontransferable.
- Parking regulations will be strictly enforced.

The following actions will result in the immediate loss of driving privileges, disciplinary actions, and/or suspension from school:

- Jumping curbs.
- Leaving campus without permission.
- Unauthorized use or falsification of a parking permit.
- Reckless operation of a motor vehicle.
- Giving, loaning, or selling a parking permit to another student.
- Non-compliance with any school official whose responsibility covers supervision of parking.
- Excessive absences or tardies to school.
