

The purpose of the uniform policy is to meet the requirements set forth by the Mobile County Public School System. Uniforms are used as a tool to ensure **student safety** through visual identification. All students are expected to observe basic standards of cleanliness, modesty, pride, good judgement, and good grooming. Clothing should fit and be worn appropriately. Students' attire considered disruptive to the educational program and/or school environment is not permitted. Head coverings (hats, bandanas, scarves, hoods, wraps etc.) are not allowed.

## ***MGM Students Uniform Policy***

<b>Shirts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 9th Grade- Black Oxford or Polo Style Shirt.</li> <li>• 10th-12th Grade White, or Carolina Blue oxford or polo style shirt.</li> <li>• <b>Shirts must be visible under outerwear.</b></li> <li>• MGM T-shirts may be worn any day of the week.</li> <li>• Shirts must be purchased or obtained through MGM only.</li> </ul> <p><b>Non-MGM SHIRTS ARE NOT PERMITTED</b></p>
<b>Pants</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Khaki Chino Pants must be full-length uniform style.</li> <li>• Khaki chino shorts may be worn. Shorts can NOT come higher than 2 inches above the knee (Bermuda or walking shorts). No fishing, sweat, jogger, or spandex type pants or shorts may be worn.</li> <li>• Sagging pants, jeggings, leggings, corduroy, sweats, capris, cargo, carpenter and jeans style pants/shorts are NOT allowed.</li> <li>• No Skirts are permitted. (Exception religious affiliation with note from pastor/priest)</li> </ul> <p><b>Pant/short construction must be uniform quality</b></p>
<b>Belts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Belts are not required but pants must be worn properly.</li> <li>• Black or Brown only.</li> </ul>
<b>Shoes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shoes must be closed toed and closed back.</li> <li>• The shoe must tie or come above the ankle.</li> <li>• Sandals/slides/slippers, high heels, crocs or house style shoes are not permitted.</li> </ul> <p><b>Shoes must be worn properly at all times.</b></p>
<b>Outerwear</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Only jackets/sweaters/ crewneck sweatshirts are permitted as outerwear.</li> <li>• Outerwear must be a <b>SOLID COLOR</b> (grey/black/white/blue/) OR MGM issued outerwear. NO LOGOS OR PICTURES that are not affiliated with MGM.</li> <li>• No shirts, blankets or sweatpants are permitted as outerwear.</li> <li>• No outerwear or clothing with other school logos are allowed.</li> <li>• No head coverings (hoods, hats, visors, scarves, bandanas, hoods, wraps. etc.) permitted on campus.</li> </ul> <p><b>No hoods are permitted on campus.</b></p>
<b>ID Badges</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ID badges must be visible at all times. Each student will receive 1 ID badge.</li> <li>• Replacement badges are \$5.00 and can be purchased from the library.</li> <li>• Badges are required for lunch, library, school events, etc.</li> </ul>
<b>Bags</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clear Bags Only (1 clear backpack will be provided to students.) Replacement bags will not be issued for lost, stolen, damaged, or torn backpacks)</li> <li>• Purses should be no larger than 7X5 in size.</li> <li>• No gym or duffle bags inside the building. (Arrangements for athletic/band students will be provided by sponsors/coaches)</li> </ul>

Any student out of uniform and unable to get into the proper uniform may not attend class according to

MCPSS policy. Repeated violations will result in suspension from school.
