Tuesday, July 28th

8:30 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. 9th grade

10:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. 8th grade

11:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. 7th grade

If you cannot make your scheduled time listed above, please come when available.
Testing will be at the Taft High School Georgia Krumnow Center foyer.

Drug Testing Consent forms must be signed by parent/guardian and turned in at the time of testing by the student or testing will not be completed.

Please Note: 6th graders are not required to test unless they are participating in UIL Activities. For example: marching band – Yes / regular band class only – No

Parents at no cost may have their child in 6th grade and up participate in the drug testing program. It serves as a tool for the students against peer pressure drug use. It can also aid in parents being made aware of drug use by their child.
