



**CITY OF WESTLAKE, OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 2026-24:**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PURCHASE ONE (1) 2025 MODEL YEAR FORD F150 PICK-UP TRUCK WITH SELECTED OPTIONS AND SAFETY EQUIPMENT THROUGH THE OPEN MARKET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Director of Purchasing desire to purchase one (1) 2025 Model Year Ford F150 Pick-up Truck with selected options and safety equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Purchasing has advised this Council that the City can purchase one (1) 2025 Model Year Ford F-150 Pick-up Truck with selected options for the Police Department from John Lance Ford LLC/Autonation Ford Westlake and associated safety equipment from a vendor to be determined through the open market.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor be and hereby is authorized to purchase one (1) 2025 Model Year Ford F150 Pick-up Truck with selected options needed for the Police Department from John Lance Ford LLC/Autonation Ford Westlake and associated safety equipment through the open market as follows:

26 **Section 2:** That the Director of Finance be and he is hereby authorized and directed to
27 issue warrants of the City of Westlake for said vehicle with safety equipment to the suppliers listed
28 in Section 1 above in a total amount not to exceed the sum of Sixty-One Thousand Dollars and
29 Zero Cents (\$61,000.00).

30 **Section 3:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
31 concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and
32 that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action
33 were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section
34 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

35 **Section 4:** That this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
36 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the
37 further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the efficiency and continuation of
38 services by the Police Department, and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-
39 thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
40 passage and approval by the Mayor.
