



**CITY OF WESTLAKE, OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 2026-13:**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO PURCHASE FITNESS EQUIPMENT FOR
THE DEPARTMENT OF RECREATION, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, this Council, by Ordinance No. 2026-1, has previously authorized the City to continue to participate in various governmental cooperative programs, including Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Purchasing has advised this Council that the City can purchase Precor fitness equipment, needed by the Department of Recreation, through the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Program, Contract No. 052324-PCR, from Health & Fitness Equipment Centers (with possible Trade-in).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor be and he hereby is authorized to purchase Precor fitness equipment, through the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Program, Contract No. 052324-PCR, needed by the Department of Recreation from Health & Fitness Equipment Centers (with possible Trade-in):

Section 2: That the Director of Finance be and he hereby is authorized and directed to issue warrants of the City of Westlake for said fitness equipment to the supplier listed in Section 1 above in an amount not to exceed the sum of One Hundred Thirteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$113,500.00).

Section 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: That this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to continue the efficiency of the Department of Recreation, and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
