



**CITY OF WESTLAKE, OHIO  
ORDINANCE NO. 2026-28:**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING VARIOUS BIDS AND  
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO  
VARIOUS CONTRACTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF  
STONE, SAND, DIRT AND GRAVEL FOR VARIOUS  
PROJECTS IN THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to an advertisement which appeared in a newspaper of general circulation, the City received seven (7) bid proposals for the purchase of stone, sand, dirt and gravel for various projects in the City of Westlake, pursuant to specifications on file in the office of the Director of Purchasing; and

**WHEREAS**, after careful analysis of such bid proposals received, the Mayor and the Director of Purchasing have recommended that Council accept the bid proposals as set forth in Section 1 herein for the aforesaid stone, sand, dirt and gravel; and

**WHEREAS**, this Council hereby finds and determines that the bid proposals are the lowest and best bid proposals for the aforesaid purchases; and

**WHEREAS**, this Council hereby accepts the bid proposals set forth in Section 1 herein and rejects all other proposals.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1:** That this Council does hereby accept the following bids for the purchase of stone, sand, dirt and gravel as needed by the City for one (1) year for repairs to be performed on various projects in the City of Westlake as set forth herein in the amounts set forth in the bid proposals of each successful bidder:

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32           **Section 2:**     That the Mayor be and he hereby is authorized and directed to enter into  
33 contracts with the companies identified in Section 1 herein, which contracts shall be in  
34 accordance with the contract documents on file in the office of the Director of Purchasing.

35           **Section 3:**     That the Director of Finance be and he hereby is authorized and directed to  
36 issue warrants of the City of Westlake made payable to the companies identified in Section 1 herein  
37 when invoices are submitted and approved by the Mayor.

38           **Section 4:**     That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council  
39 concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and  
40 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action  
41 were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section  
42 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

43           **Section 5:**     That this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure  
44 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the  
45 further reason that it is immediately necessary to continue the efficiency of the various City  
46 Department’s repairs and projects, and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-  
47 thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its  
48 passage and approval by the Mayor.
