6 **ORDINANCE NO. 2025-21 AS TO A CONTRACT**
7 **WITH SET IN STONE FOR THE 2025 SIDEWALK**
8 **REPAIR PROGRAM FOR THE CITY OF**
9 **WESTLAKE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

12 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2025-21, Council accepted the bid and authorized
13 the Mayor to enter into a contract with Set in Stone for the 2025 Sidewalk Repair Program; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Director of Engineering recommend Section 2 of Ordinance
15 No. 2025-21 be amended to provide additional funds for completion of the project.

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF**
17 **WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:**

18 **Section 1:** That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 2025-21 be and the same is hereby
19 amended and as amended shall read as follows:

20 **Section 2:** That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed
21 to issue warrants of the City of Westlake to Set in Stone in an amount not to exceed
22 ~~One Two~~ Million ~~Six Seven~~ Hundred ~~Eighty Seven~~ Thousand ~~Three Hundred~~
23 Dollars and Zero Cents (~~\$1,687,300.00~~\$2,700,000.00) when approved by the Mayor
24 and the Director of Engineering.”

25 **Section 2:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
26 concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and
27 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action
28 were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section
29 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

30 **Section 3:** That this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
31 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the
32 further reason that it is immediately necessary to complete the 2025 Sidewalk Repair Program,
33 and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to

34 Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the
35 Mayor.
